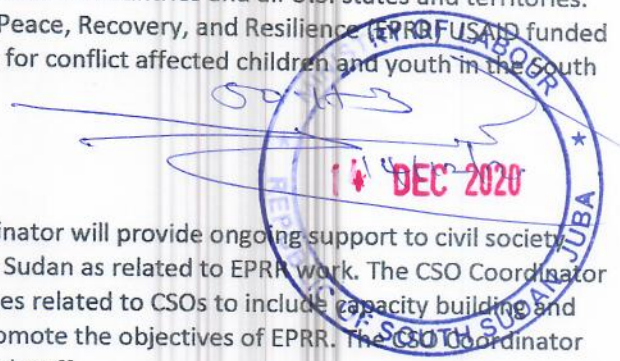

Under the supervision of the Deputy Chief of Party, the CSO Coordinator will provide ongoing support to civil society organizations (CSOs) and foster positive civic engagement in South Sudan as related to EPRR work. The CSO Coordinator will be responsible for the day-to-day management of EPRR activities related to CSOs to include capacity building and training for conflict mitigation, civic education, and advocacy to promote the objectives of EPRR. The CSO Coordinator will also provide mentorship and training, as needed, for all national staff.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

The CSO coordinator will report directly to EPRR DCOP and the position's primary responsibilities include:

- Supervise day-to-day management of civil society strengthening activities and oversee activities of civil society desk officers and trainers.
- Provide technical expertise to build capacity of local CSOs for conflict mitigation, civic education, and advocacy.
- Support CSOs to promote
  - Increase Access to Equitable Learning Opportunities for Boys and Girls to support civil society engagement with the peace process.
  - Implement activities that promote school safety
  - Provide teaching and learning materials, including supplemental reading materials.
  - Provide additional incentives to encourage student attendance.
  - Improve Learning Outcomes through Enhanced Literacy and Numeracy Instruction
  - Provide incentives to volunteer teachers
  - Train volunteer teachers to teach literacy and numeracy
  - Provide on-going mentoring to volunteer teachers
  - Implement activities to support a reading Enhance Recovery and Resilience through Psychosocial Support and Peacebuilding culture
  - Equip school community members with psychosocial, peacebuilding, and life skills
  - Equip teachers and PTA with skills to provide others with psychosocial support knowledge and skills
  - Support teachers to apply psychosocial informed approaches to the teaching and learning process
  - 2 Support teachers and PTA to roll out and implement peacebuilding and life skills activities at beneficiary schools
  - Provide materials to support psychosocial support, peacebuilding and life skills activities
  - Enhance Capacity of Communities especially PTAs/SMCs, to support education
  - Train PTAs/SMCs on roles and responsibilities of PTA members
- Liaise with donors, international organizations, and government actors, as needed.
- Oversee program reporting and M&E responsibilities, including biweekly and quarterly report submissions and consistent M&E data collection and tracking, coordinating closely with EPRR management.
- Provide input into yearly work plan and indicator targets together with program leadership team and oversee implementation of the USAID-approved work plan.
- Work in collaboration with operations, security, and finance teams to ensure smooth running of the program, compliance with all USAID and FHI's policies and regulations, and secure and effective EPRR operations.



**Eligibility:** All positions are local hire. To be eligible, applicants must have South Sudan citizenship, permanent residence or current valid work authorization.
