ICT Graduate Internship Selection criteria:

- Interns must be South Sudanese who has graduated in 2019 or in his/her last semester to complete studies between September and December 2019.
- Interns must have a relevant qualification in information Technology.
- Interns should have a first or second Degree from an accredited university with no prior work experience.
- Interns must be residents of Juba where the opportunity is located.
- Interns must be willing to share in Our Values, Our Vision and promise to Children.
- Interns who show genuine desire to serve among the poor in rural and semi urban areas of South Sudan.
- Interns with demonstrated good character, honesty, high competency and generally in good physical and emotional health.
- Interns who are open to declare any potential points for conflict of interest e.g. a family member working for WORLD VISION SOUTH SUDAN etc.
- Willingness to commit to the program for a period of one year or at least 8 months.

Facilitation:

Successful Interns shall not be entitled to a salary as this is not an employment. However, the experience you will acquire is priceless, such as "on the job" valuable training, exploring career paths, professional networking and so on. Nevertheless, Interns will be provided with a monthly stipend (50 USD for Field based Interns for upkeep which shall be taxed as per South Sudan Revenue Authority regulations if applicable.
