Project background

Welthungerhilfe in South Sudan has been implementing activities in nine locations in the states of Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Greater Equatoria and Unity since 2011, with its programs in humanitarian assistance, rural development, livelihoods, nutrition and food security, and WASH sectors. Currently WHH South Sudan implements projects across five states in South Sudan.

Job purpose:

The post holder is responsible for providing a high-level IT and application support to WHH country office and its sub-offices. Coordinate with Regional IT department to administrate IT services such as WHH's office 365 and exchange online accounts, Adobe, ArcGIS Licensing, and internet maintenance and troubleshooting.

IT Manager will support the Head of Operations in delivering a first-class support service to WHH staff and offices, acting primarily in a first line support capacity, resolving issues in person, over the phone or via remote connectivity.

IT Manager reports to Head of Operations and line manages IT Officer. Works closely with Regional IT Advisor.



Key responsibilities:

Duties and Responsibilities

A. IT

- Install and configure computer operating systems, printers, networks, and applications.
- Monitor and maintain WHH's network performance.
- Troubleshoot hardware and software issues in person, remotely and via phone.
- Ensure all WHH users have access to all relevant licensed software, including Adobe, MS office and GIS software.
- Ensure procurement of IT equipment meets WHH's global standards.
- Ensure IT equipment is updated in the asset database and stock in cooperation with the Logistic Expert.

B. Data protection

- Maintain the project's/programme's hardware and software.
 - Ensure the functioning of all hardware (laptops, servers, desktop computers) in accordance with Welthungerhilfe standards.
 - Maintain printers, digital cameras, scanners and other hardware components.
 - Ensure smooth running of all software packages used at Welthungerhilfe office.
- Manage the installation and security of information technology components and systems.
 - Manage the overall administration of the IT system.
 - Install and maintain a local area network (LAN)
 - Document installation and settings on the server and on each computer
 - Establish proper back-up systems and ensure system security.
 - Periodically update anti-virus software
