PURPOSE AND SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

Under supervision and guidance of Head of Base. Heads of Department and close collaboration with sectors Program Managers provide support in operationalization of programs in the Mission through technical support, building capacities of staff and liaise with the focal points at state level for efficient management and functioning of program/services on ground.

The Deputy Multi-sectoral Program Manager position is charged with implementing the Action Against Hunger South Sudan Nutrition, WASH, FSL and Gender technical strategy, manage current projects and identify new, creative and innovative opportunities for WASH, Nutrition, FSL, Health and Gender programming.

TASK & RESPONSIBILITIES

Key to the role is overseeing quality and timely implementation of Nutrition interventions to ensure continuity of effective service delivery and save lives.

The Multi-Sector Deputy Programme Manager is responsible for overseeing the planning and implementation of ACF Multi-sectoral programmes activities and the management of the grants funding projects. As such, he/she is accountable in ensuring support to:

- Lead the sector in the absence of the program manager (WASH PM, FSL PM, GBV and NUT PM)
- Develop and submit the work plan and update on monthly basis:
- Identify gaps/needs on program activities and training and implement accordingly:
- Make close follow-up on program implementation and track the quality indicators:
- Organize and conduct regular monitoring & evaluation:



- Organize monthly or need based meetings with the team and report the outcome;
- Review the daily and monthly reports of the team and compile; If there is a problem, find out what went wrong and find a solution or else contact your immediate supervisor;
- In case of a conflict between team members be able to mediate:
- Participate on staff appraisal;
- Help the program managers in any task, when required
- Provide support to the WASH teams in running and supervision of water, sanitation and hygiene programs at all stages of the Project management cycle.
- Support WASH teams in developing a program plan, ensure its smooth implementation, and manage the teams performance of Project tasks and activities that may include, but are not limited to:
- Track the progress of activities, collection of program indicators and provide on-time internal status reports and external donor reports
- Identify and monitor risks, constraints or escalating issues, and inform the hierarchy accordingly.
- In collaboration with program managers and officers collect, organize and update all program data and information and ensure they easily accessible; and that lessons learnt and best practice are capitalized.
- Coordinate with other technical departments to optimize a common approach, synergy and sharing of information.
- Represent Action Against Hunger externally and collaborate/coordinate with local authorities, clusters, State level ICCG, counterparts, partners and stakeholders.
- Manage the project officers in collaboration with Program managers. Medical Officer and WASH/FSL/Nutrition/Gender Officers (in case of the absence of WASH/FSL/Nutrition/GBV Manager) and gender officers through definition of objectives that will help him/her reach his/her full potential and achieve the objectives of the program.
- Build capacity of the program teams on monitoring and reporting indicators and data management (WASH, FSL, GBV and Nutrition)
- Support in development of job descriptions of program team on ground (technical component), as well as, development of interview guides.
- Coordinate with HR department in the recruitment and on boarding of qualified program project staffs and volunteers in collaboration with Program managers
- Conduct staff appraisals on the technical competencies, jointly with project Officers.
- Build the capacity of Project Officers on administrative tasks of planning, organizing, supervising, budget management, implementation of a nutrition program, monitoring, evaluation, report writing, data management, communication, proposal writing, human resource management, conducting assessment and surveys.

- Work closely with Program manager/Head of Base and or Heads of Department to prioritize program/project team training objectives.
- Conduct weekly meeting with program/project teams and share minute/action points to the team, and monitor the implementation of the action points.
- Oriented and train newly recruited staff are on important gender related policies, standards and code of conducts that AAH South Sudan Mission is abided with
- Coordination of the programs with Emergency programs and among the staff of each department on various areas including training, resource use, data collection and analysis.
- Promote and facilitate the integration of WASH, NUT, FSL, Health and GBV
- In the absence of program manager oversees WASH, Nutrition, GBV and FSL projects and team,
- Coordinate with national office and other Bases for sharing of relevant information, best practices, knowledge and experience, resources, etc.
- * Reinforce collaboration with SMoH, donors and other partners at the state level,
- Actively participate in state level clusters and humanitarian coordination meetings in coordination with the Head of Base and Nutrition Head of Department.
- Advocate with staff, partner and government for support of gender related activities and including gender mainstreaming in respective programs.
- Represent AAH in relevant gender related forums and networks for knowledge sharing and dissemination of good practices on gender related mainstreaming.
- Perform any other duty as requested by line managers.
- Program Director: functional relationship technical supervision and support exchange of information
- Program manager: hierarchical relationship, reporting lines, support.
- Others Programme staff: exchange of information and coordination with other programs to maximize the impact of activities.
