FUNCTION: HEALTH FIELD OFFICER 2
PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT: BOR

Under supervision of the Health Delegate, Health Field Officer 2 promotes and ensures the delivery of high-quality patient care aimed at reaching national/international standards depending on the context. S/he works to build capacity in nursing care and infection control in ICRC-assisted or independent health facilities often working with limited resources and in challenging conditions. Provides accurate translation from English to Arabic and local languages and vice versa.

FUNCTION DESCRIPTION

- Implements health programmes within his/her geographic area or field of responsibility/ expertise.
- Assists the Health Delegate, Mental Health and Psychosocial Delegate or Health Coordinator or Health Project Manager in designing operational strategies and planning the health programme(s) at local/facility and national levels.
- Conducts assessments and regular field visits (when relevant) to monitor activities and health-related threats to the population.
- Ensures proper management of information collected and appropriate, relevant reporting.
- Participates in analysis of and reflection on the overall health situation; contributes to realistic project proposals in line with the delegation's objectives and priorities.
- Helps organize meetings; advises staff members on various matters such as culture, politics, the economy, security, etc.
- Interprets at meetings and translates documents into local languages.
- Liaises and builds networks with local stakeholders to facilitate communication on and coordination of activities, thereby ensuring more efficient implementation of health programmes.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Degree in medicine, nursing or other relevant health profession (e.g. psychology, psychiatry).
- Qualifications in public health or health management a strong asset.
- Fluent written and spoken command of the local working language as well as English and/or Arabic.
- 6 to 10 years of total work experience in field of expertise.
- Good connections with local health authorities or groups of interest for the ICRC.
- Excellent knowledge of the assigned geographic area.
