ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND

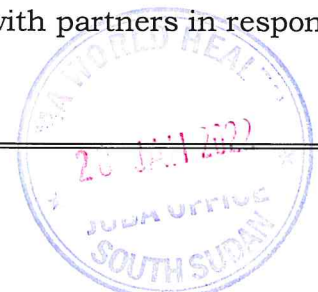

POSITION DESCRIPTION

Under the guidance and close supervision of the County primary Health care supervisor and with technical support of the Community Service Advisor and Services Strengthening Advisor, The Community Liaison Officer is responsible for coordination and collaboration between the facility and community, specifically regarding strengthening community-to-facility linkages to improve continuity of care throughout the life of the project, work in collaboration with other health providers, prepare and submit report on weekly and monthly

Duties and Responsibilities

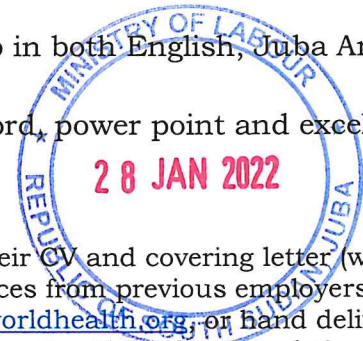
- Support the rollout of SBC activities and the small grants program in MIHR project areas as required related to demand generation and community engagement
- Support quality improvement team and the roll out of social accountability activities in the community, including youth
- Work closely with facility-based staff and SBC/Gender advisor to ensure quality of activities through the provision of regular feedback on activities through routine monitoring tools for continuous improvement
- Support rollout of SBC communication activities/messages with partners in response to COVID-19 and other shocks and stressors



- Provide input into regular and ad hoc technical reports for HQ, MIHR team or USAID, as required
- Liaise with the resilience team to ensure SBC and gender activities support resilient individuals, families, and communities
- Supervise BHWs and provide guidance and training to improve continuity of care
- Comply BHWs weekly/monthly report and submit to MIHR MEL team with a copy to community services delivery Advisor.

Education, skills and experience required

- Bachelor's and/or master's degree in social sciences, public health, and similar areas
- At least 3-7 years of experience preferably in community engagement, social and behavior change, and gender for country level projects, for which at least 4 years were working in the field of international development
- Possess appropriate organizational, analytic, oral, and written communications skills as well as demonstrated supervisory experience
- Fluency in English with strong verbal and written skills required (professional level)
- Excellent communication skills and an ability to demonstrate empathy and understanding towards the target group
- Ability and confidence to speak in front of a large group in both English, Juba Arabic, and local community language
- Good computer literacy skills with proficiency in MS word, power point and excel.
- Ability to work with others in a team.
