The Position

NCA is looking for a competent and experienced candidate to fill the position of staff House Driver based in Juba, Central Equatoria State.

Areas of Responsibility

- Provide logistical support to NCA operations in the staff house
- Ensure that the vehicle assigned to him/her is in good and road worthy condition at all time
- Ensure that the interior and exterior of the vehicle is kept clean with no poisonous substances on board
- Ensure compliance to Covid -19 protocols set out by the South Sudan Government

Main Tasks

- Facilitate the movement of NCA staff within the city of Juba
- Pick and drop staff from/to their residence in the morning and evening during the week
- Inspect the vehicle assigned to him/her every morning and ensure any default that is detected is reported to the supervisor
- Facilitate movement of the international staff at night and over the weekend
- Fill the logbook for the vehicle as instructed by the supervisor and report the expiry of the same
- Clean the vehicle thoroughly on daily basis both internal and external
- Obey traffic rules and regulations and NCA safety regulations while driving
- Work from Wednesday through Sunday and be off on Monday and Tuesday
- Identity/trouble shoot minor faults in a vehicle and rectify
- Be willing to spend nights at NCA staff house
- Drop staff to the airport early in the morning
- Drive during public holiday

Educational Qualifications, Experience and Skills

- Hold at least a secondary school certificate
- Formal training in motor vehicle mechanic is an added advantage
- Should have served in a similar position in a non-Governmental Organisation or UN agencies for at least 5 years in the same capacity
- Must posses a recognized and valid South Sudan driving certificate/license
- Fluent in spoken Arabic
- Fluent in spoken and written English
- Should be computer literate
- Good understanding of the cultural environment and good working relations with local authorities
- Must Posses the values of integrity, honesty, and service to humanity
- Good track record from current or former employer
