## The Position and Areas of Responsibility

This position is responsible for development and implementation of a comprehensive communication strategy to support NCA's organizational objectives and enhance stakeholder engagement & visibility. The communication officer is responsible for the execution of key communication directives established at head office and maintain alignment between the country-specific communication strategy and these guidelines. Oversee the development of high-quality, tailored content for various communication platforms including project briefs, annual reports, press releases, impact stories, and social media updates

S/he provides technical advice and capacity support to the NCA staff and partners on communication, ensure NCA-SS visibility is of high quality and contributes to achieving the objectives of the programme, sector, and organization.

- Develop and implement communication strategies to engage with key stakeholders such as donors, government bodies, development partners, and the general public.
- Collaborate with departments to enhance internal and external communication and ensure the documentation and visibility of programmatic results
- Ensure consistent messaging and adherence to organizational brand guidelines across all communications and marketing materials.
- Provide communication counsel to senior leadership, preparing them for speeches, media interviews, and public engagements.
