BACKGROUND

RTI is an international, independent not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving the human condition through multidisciplinary technical assistance, training and research services that meet the highest standards of professional performance. We are currently seeking qualified, experienced, dynamic, and highly motivated candidates for a Roving Clinical Supervisor consultancy position to be partially based in Juba, with planned travels to Wau, Bor, and selected outreach sites within South Sudan.

Summary Description of The Position

As an RTI international staff, the Clinical supervisor is responsible for overall project performance to client requirements and satisfaction, and in conformance with RTI policies, procedures, and guidelines, working closely with the RTI Clinical Manager and Technical team to ensure technical and operational management and quality control. The Clinical Supervisor will also perform other roles, as necessary.

Specific responsibilities

- Provide technical assistance and oversight on planning and implementation of Voluntary Male Medical Circumcision (VMMC) mobile outreach services and all related activities in selected sites in Central Equatoria, Wau and Jonglei States.
- Under the supervision of the Clinical Program Manager, provide necessary technical assistance to guide planning and implementation of HIV prevention, care, and treatment activities in support of the SSPDF HIV Secretariat in Juba Military Hospital, Wau, Malual Chaat and New Site Clinic.
- Participate in commodity forecasting and distribution to avoid stock outs and program disruptions.
- Participate in conducting training, technical assistance, technical support supervision and other quality assurance and quality improvement activities on HIV and VMMC program.
- Provide technical input in the design of interventions to link identified HIV clients to comprehensive care and treatment services and ensure treatment adherence.

- Provide technical assistance in implementation of HIV/TB comprehensive services at Juba Military Hospital, New Site Clinic, Wau Military Hospital and Malual Chaat Military Hospital.
- Provide guidance and capacity building support to contracted Civil Society Implementing partner (s) on VMMC program, HIV testing, care & treatment, and Interruption in treatment PLHIV tracing activities.
- Support analysis and submission of monthly data reports on VMMC performance to the RTI M&E Officer based at the Juba Office.
- Participate in support field supervision visits to review progress and ensure quality assurance in line with national Ministry of Health and PEPFAR guidelines.
- Contribute to development of project work plans and progress reports.
- Assist SSPDF HIV Secretariat field M&E Officers in analysis and review of quality program data and the generation of monthly reports.
- Assist with administrative duties as needed.



Minimum Required Education & Experience

- Bachelor's degree or diploma in relevant field (e.g., clinical medicine).
- Minimum of five years of professional experience, in HIV programming specifically in comprehensive ART management.
- Minimum knowledge in Voluntary Medical Male Circumcision (VMMC) as an approved key HIV preventive method.
- Proven competence working with diverse stakeholders, such as members of local government, military population, health workers, and local organizations and communities.
- Ability to organize and implement training, capacity-building, and skills transfer.
- Demonstrated knowledge, skills and abilities in the conducting various types of HTS e.g., PICT, VCT and modes of HTS programming e.g., facility-based, home-based and workplace-based.
- Experience in MOH supply chain management system, commodities and pharmaceutical projection forecasting and stock management through delivery notes and stocks cards.
- Ability to provide mentorship, supervision and on job training to facility staff.
- Pay attention to details, data quality and reporting cycles and timelines.
- Excellent computer skills, Word processing, spreadsheets. Report writing skills.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills in English and Juba Arabic.
