ROLE PURPOSE:

The nutrition promoters will work at the PHCC/Us or outreach sites and ensure there is screening referral and management of malnourished children. They shall be key in working together with Community Nutrition Volunteers to ensure that key messaging on MIYCN/CMAM are passed to the community and harmful practices avoided.

KEY AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY:

Measurer/screener

To weigh and measure weight, height, MUAC and check for presence of oedema of the beneficiaries in line with the CMAM training received.

Talk to and reassure the beneficiaries during the weighing and measuring process to attain their patience and confidence.

To send ineligible children home/to the clinic if necessary (clearly explain to mother) why the beneficiary is not enrolled in the program.

For new or current beneficiaries, record the measurements accurately on the beneficiary's card.
 Organise the measuring area appropriately and ensure there is adequate seating area for the beneficiaries.

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Registrar

To ensure that each beneficiary eligible for the programme is admitted to the correct programme and issued a ration card.

> To ensure that the beneficiary's details are recorded correctly and accurately on the card, registration book, treatment book and any other relevant document for follow up and accountability.

To ensure that the weight and MUAC is recorded on the card each week, height each month and the weight for height percentage calculated accurately.

To clearly communicate and discuss with the beneficiary caretaker the status and progress of the child on each follow up date.

> To ensure that the beneficiaries are discharged using appropriate discharge criteria as per CMAM guideline.

CMAM activities

- Work with CNVs and mother leads to develop and maintain a referral system at community level in which community health workers refer malnourished children and mothers needing special attention to the health facilities.
- Plan, implement and monitor/evaluate CMAM activities in the catchment areas.
- Ensure quality of management and adherence to protocol through active supervision and on job training to CNVs and Lead mothers.
- Organize and facilitate regular trainings (including refresher trainings) for MOH staff in the health facilities on Community management of acute malnutrition.
- Ensure ongoing community mobilization activities including satisfactory active case finding, referral, follow ups and health education.
- Ensure sufficient OTP/TSFP rations are received at the site, monitor distribution, any balances returned to the store and complete stock reconciliation records are done on daily basis.
- Ensure timely requisition of Nutrition supplies, items and equipment for effective and timely implementation.
- Consult with the Nutrition Officer and liaise closely with nutrition programme staff and other relevant partners (community leaders, MoH staff, other agency staff etc.) regarding progress nutrition activities.
- > Seek and provide feedback and alter programme as appropriate to maximise impact of the programming in the catchment areas.
- Participate in CMAM general programme management duties as requested by Nutrition officer.

Monitoring and Evaluation

- Participate in the design, development and implementation of an M&E framework for all nutrition treatment activities.
- Write reports to document the process of implementation, lessons learnt and good practice and ensure information is widely disseminated
- To ensure beneficiaries are discharged as per the protocols
- Collation and analysis of other existing surveillance data
- Participate in the design and execution of nutrition surveys according to national guidelines

Ensure ongoing surveillance activities, through organizing regular screening in the catchment areas.

Participate in the preparation monthly activity reports as well as quarterly reports.

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Management and Supervision

- > Develop a comprehensive plan for supervision of all the field nutrition activities
- Assist the CNVs and mother leads implementing nutrition & MIYCN activities to develop monthly work plans.
- Mentor, supervise and support CNVs & Mother leads to ensure that they conduct activities in the community as required.
- Ensure regular meetings with the CNVs & Mother Lead and Health workers.
- Perform appraisal to CNVs and recommend training opportunities based on evaluation outcomes.
- Document and share lessons learnt in a comprehensive and detailed manner to enable track trends on changes on a timely basis
- Attend community sensitization and program review and feedback meetings
- > Perform any other duties that may be assigned to you by your supervisor
