Position summary

Under direct supervision of the Principal Investigator, you will effectively coordinate the implementation of the Accelerating Africa Adolescent Hub research project in Nimule Town, South Sudan designed to test the impact of Orphans and Vulnerable Children Intervention on health outcomes for adolescents living with or affected by HIV and AIDS. The study utilizes a combination of development accelerators including adolescent's sexual and reproductive health and social protections for improving adolescent health outcomes. We are looking for a dynamic and competent Research Coordinator to oversee the technical implementation of all study activities including recruitment and randomization of study participants, training of study team, supporting MEALF officer in data collection and analysis, participation in all coordination meetings with key stakeholders and supervision of field teams, backstop administrative and logistical support including IRB approval applications, pre-testing and refining tools, coordinating training, data collection, data analysis, study documentation and ensuring protocol adherence before, during and after the survey. He/she will maintain constant communication and provide regular updates to study investigators and implement feedback. This position requires a one-year commitment with the potential for extension at the end of the period, subject to funding



Key Responsibilities

Research Planning and Design

- Conducts all research activities in accordance with study protocol and procedures and other appropriate institutional regulations, procedures and policies, including procedures to safeguard confidentiality of study participants 10%
- Screens potential participants to determine eligibility for study participation, collects locator and demographic information, coordinates participant study visit activities and follow up including but not limited to scheduling visits, tracking scheduled follow up visits, provide reminder letters and calls for follow up visits and conducts other activities to retain study participants -10%
- Oversees the collection and transport of study specimen to research lab and ensure timely request and delivery of study drug from the research pharmacy to the site 10%
- Completes study specific data collection forms and maintains source documentation as per protocol guidelines 10%
- Refers participants to healthcare providers and other needed services in coordination with the research clinicians 10%
- Assist with community outreach activities, which may encompass, community education, contacting community organizations, promoting collaborative efforts among organizations/programs and stakeholders, and attending community meetings and other relevant community meetings - 5%
- Implements continuous quality improvement processes to ensure integrity of data collected and/or entered into study databases, and performs quality assurance activities in collaboration with the site's Data Officer 5%
- Employs intensive strategies to track and retain study participants and re-engage participants missing study visits 5%
- Participates in regular meetings with study personnel to ensure high-quality performance of job responsibilities 5%
- In collaboration with the MOH, technically guide in the set-up of the Adolescent Hub project site in Nimule Town
- Lead frequent supervision and monitoring visits to program sites and regions
- Attend study related trainings and meetings as requested by the PI 5%
- Liaise with UN agencies who are part of the HUB especially UNICEF, UNDP and UNAIDS
- Perform other related duties as assigned 5%
