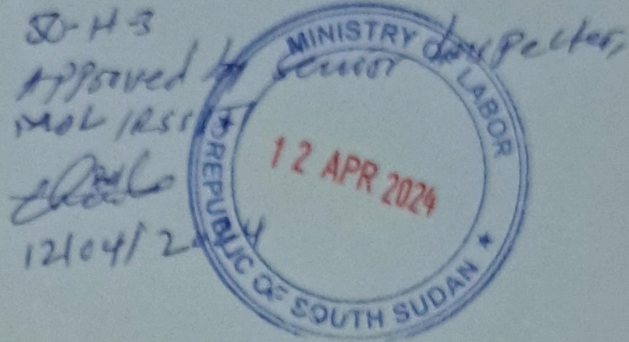

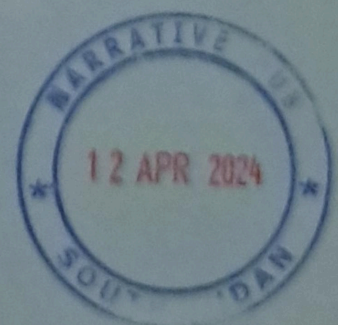
Back ground.

Narrative Hub (NH) is a women-led national NGO that provides innovative, community-based, and sustainable approaches to solving South Sudan's intractable problems. The Hub strives to influence programming through creating an environment in which positive developments and, thus, positive stories can unfold in sectors ranging from rights, access to justice, protection, education, and livelihoods improvement. It is a process spearheaded by community volunteers, who are change agents that we refer to as "voices of transformation" as they seek to change others through their stories in what we call the "transformational stories" told within communities. Those stories are told/depicted orally, through music, traditional/cultural songs and dances, drama or skits/role plays, then documented and shared through audio-visuals or in written format. Narrative Hub is legally registered by Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) in South Sudan under registration no. 1,099. We place special focus on working alongside women living in poverty because, equipped with proper resources, women have the power to help whole families and entire communities move out of poverty.

- Work closely with program team, M & E manager and other senior managers the including program development manager to develop new protection programs.



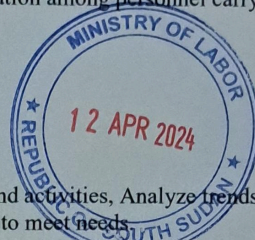
- Manage the overall protection implementation (GBV, child protection and gender) programming.
- Quality control and impact reporting of projects particularly on theory of change, success stories, lesson learnt.
- Donor reporting, internal communication and coordination among personnel carry out project implementation.

Roles and Responsibilities

- support the overall implementation of protection projects and activities, Analyze trends of GBV/ child protection and develop/adjust program strategies to meet needs.
- Contribute to program design and the preparation of concept notes and proposals.
- Identify and reinforce existing support mechanisms and work closely with local counterparts to ensure community buy-in and cultural appropriateness of activities
- Strengthen case management and referral systems for GBV and child protection in all the project locations.
- Work with teams and communities to develop appropriate prevention and awareness-raising/behavior change strategies.
- Train GBV staff to become leaders of GBV and prevention and response. Depending on skill sets and required roles, trainings may include: gender, guiding principles of addressing GBV, GBV case management, referral pathway development, compassionate care, facilitation skills, mobilization, project cycle management, etc.
- Contribute to information-sharing and data management and data protection.
- Compile monthly and quarterly reports, on time and with accurate data
- Maintain flexibility to take on added responsibility as and when needed.
- Coordinate with local and international NGOs, UN agencies and other stakeholders to ensure holistic support for survivors, including participation in strengthening GBV SOPs and referral pathways.
- Actively participate in protection/GBV working groups and contribute to interagency initiatives, also promoting Narrative Hub as a leader agency in GBV.
