Action Against Hunger-USA is part of the Action Against Hunger International network, which provides humanitarian relief in over 40 countries worldwide in the sectors of nutrition, health, water/sanitation, and food security. Action Against Hunger-USA, an independent NGO, currently manages operations in seven countries: Kenya, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, Ethiopia, Haiti and Somalia. Action Against Hunger-USA has approximately 1,500 staff based in the various country offices, Head Quarter in New York City and Operational Centre in Nairobi. Additional growth is anticipated.

1 SUMMARY OF POSITION

The Purpose of this position is to plan and provide medical and nursing care to patients in hospital, at home or in other settings who are suffering from chronic or acute physical or mental ill health. A caring and compassionate nature and the ability to deal with emotionally charged and pressured situations are important traits of this Position.

The MET-Nurse role is designed with the following purpose, engagement and delivery.

11. **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- 1. Provide technical leadership and technical support related to clinical management of IMNCI, PLW and emergencies through clinical diagnosis and case treatment based on World Health Organization (WHO) recommendations and National guidelines.
 - Warmly welcome patient/beneficiaries, making them feel comfortable within the facility and explain the procedures and treatment option decide on.
 - Integrate nutrition and health services through an Integrated Management of Neonatal and Childhood Illnesses approach (IMNCI), with a focus on basic lifesaving maternal, new-born and child healthcare, communicable disease prevention and control, detection and treatment of acute malnutrition, and promotion of breastfeeding.
 - Take history of patients and verify vaccination status, conduct ensure clinical examination/review of patient and document on the patients treatment card/book.
 - Make diagnosis based on the patients' history and lab tests results (if done) and liaise with the medical officer in charge or Health expert on the best treatment options available at the site.
 - Conduct effective triage of patients and provide attention to those critical cases.
 - Give the correct dosage of medications as per the protocol
 - Provide medical and nutritional treatments to the patients and beneficiaries, in accordance with WHO and national protocols, and in respect appropriate hygiene measures;
 - Adhere to SC admission criteria as per the protocol. Prepare and dispense sugar water and F7% upon admission for SAM cases with medical complications.
 - Take anthropometric measurement of the patients and record on the treatment sheet/file
 - Calculate, prepare, distribute and monitor consumption of the therapeutic milk (F75, F100) according to the standard protocols for the SAM with medical complications.
 - Correctly register all patient/beneficiaries information in the register and consistently update patient records and report any problems to the line manager and technical line manager or Health Expert (Roving Dr)
 - Foster cooperation by the caregivers by explaining the facility procedures and operations and explain the role of the caretakers of the sick children.
 - Provide psychological support to the mothers/caregivers of the patients at the facility.
 - Develop health and nutrition educational messages for patients, beneficiaries, caretakers and
 - Patients management: monitoring of the nutritional and medical status of the beneficiaries i.e. temperature, the pulse, the general wellbeing and correctly record the information in the patients' follow-up card

Protection of referral pathways (GBV & psycho-social support)

- In close collaboration with the roving Social Workers, MET PMs, the nurse will participate in provision of basic social support and in mapping of the community referral pathways in areas of MET and SURGE deployment while participating in the development of materials for consumption of the team and beneficiaries.
- Participate in training of all MET and SURGE teams on facilitation of referral pathways.
- Provide psychosocial assistance that aims to promote, protect and support the well-being of affected person (e.g.; GBV cases)

3. PHC services management, reporting and HR

- Monitor the construction, rehabilitation and maintenance of all the structures related to the functioning of the MET program (office, team-house, warehouse, OTP sites, etc.)
- Assess the condition and provide a timely rehabilitation/maintenance of the field base of the
- receipt, storage, accounting and reporting of all items receipts received and stored in the warehouse(s).
- Prepare and supervise loading, offloading and ensure all documents are duly filled and signed
- Provide secure storage space and condition for ACF'S properties; ensuring that the items are kept in good condition, supervises the power, water and cleaning supplies and carries out checks
- Supports management of compound's power/electricity system

Stock management for the base, monitors the stock consumption rate of consumables and coordinates for replenishment.
