



Terms of Reference for “Consultant WASH Expert for Water Points and Sanitation Facilities Functionality in Gumbo /Sherikat Township, Juba South Sudan”

1. Background

Amref Health Africa has a longstanding partnership with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ). In the past 3 months, Amref has implemented a WASH KAP Survey in Gumbo Township to generate household-specific WASH data which, will inform the design of social and behavior change interventions within an intended large scale WASH programme targeted at both the internally displaced persons living in the camp and non-camp residents. Amref has now obtained additional funding to carry out a Water Point and Toilet/Latrine Functionality Assessment in Gumbo Township. The functionality assessment information will provide additional geo-referenced visualizations for targeted intervention. Interventions will include household hygiene promotion and improvement of water supply system in Gumbo.

Working under the direct supervision of Amref WASH Coordinator, and in coordination with the MEAL Manager WASH Expert, the consultant will responsible for the technical implementation of the Water point functionality assessment and Toilet/Latrine Mapping in Gumbo. The consultant will consequently be required to ensure a smooth implementation of the assessment as per the responsibilities and accountabilities indicated below.

2. Responsibilities

1. Evaluate the overall implementation status of the Functionality Assessment with particular attention to Amref and GIZ requirements and rules and regulations in terms of the quality, budget, expected results and timelines and provide recommendations for the timely and successful completion of all planned activities
2. Ensure adequate supervision of the technical components of the assessment
3. Conduct water Quality Tests on all Water Points based of Twelve selected WTQ parameters and review the results as necessary to guarantee quality reporting on the water quality in Gumbo
4. Conduct Toilet/Latrine and Sanitation Infrastructure assessment and Mapping in Gumbo
5. Ensure quality socio-demographic information is collected and linked to the sanitation infrastructure in Gumbo
6. Prepare and submit Assessment report to the MEAL Manager and WASH Coordinator ensure that all the data and information is archived and shared appropriately.



7. Perform such other technical and operational duties as may be necessary for successful implementation of the functionality assessment.

3. Deliverables/Expected outputs

- i. A preliminary report on Water Point and Sanitation Infrastructure Functionality Assessment;
- ii. A Final Technical Report including: a) Status of water points and Toilets/Latrines including digital maps (at appropriate scales).
- iii. One day workshop for project team on findings of Functionality Assessment.

4. Duration of the Assignment

5. Required Qualifications and Experience

Education

- Master's degree in Civil Engineering, Water Engineering, Engineering, Public Health or a related field from an accredited academic institution with five years of relevant professional experience; or
- University degree in the above fields with seven years of relevant professional experience.

Experience

- Experience managing WASH projects in an emergency setting;
- Supervision of WASH infrastructure;
- Skills and knowledge on the planning, design, execution and supervision of piped water systems is essential;
- Proven track record of working with government officials, UN agencies, NGO and communities in the execution of WASH projects;
- Experience liaising with donors, government officials and other stakeholders and a proven track record of resource mobilization;
- Ability to prepare clear and concise reports;
- Knowledge and experience working with GIZs administrative procedures a distinct advantage
