Job Purpose

The Clinical Officer is responsible for overseeing health care activities for HAA supported health facilities in Canal Pigi in Jonglei state and other Selected Areas.

The responsibilities will include day to day support to health facilities, monitoring of activities, report making, coordination with other sectors and government authorities as well as close collaboration with health facility staff and managers. The Clinical Officer will supervise other Mid cadre health care field staff and provide on job mentoring and supportive supervision in dispensing clinical duties

Functional Duties/Responsibilities

- Conduct Outpatient Consultations (OPD) in the designated facilities in compliance with the standardized protocols, policies and guidelines, as outlined by the South Sudan Ministry of Health (SMOH) and WHO. Ensure that all health activities are consistent with established best practices.
- In collaboration with the other health program staff in the field, organize weekly outreaches to the remote villages to offer health care services to the hard to reach Populations.
