JOB PURPOSE

The Surgeon will support CCM in managing hospitals surgical services and general hospital management in CCM supported Hospitals. The incumbent will be part of the senior management team of the hospital, will be the Head of Department of Surgical Ward, and will closely monitor and supervise hospital services.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To be responsible for the management of hospital surgical services and general hospital management in the supported CCM hospital
- To organize and conduct trainings based on the identified needs
- To ensure coordination with the Hospital Directors and any other relevant stakeholders
- To proper and timely collect and present programmes results
- Support Programme Manager developing periodic reports
- Support Programme Manager in dealing with any other tasks as may be required

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Programme implementation, development and monitoring

- Carry out elective and emergency (minor and major) surgical operations based on needs and availability of supplies;
- Assist in the supervision of the overall hospital services provision
- Conduct regular surgical screening and book patient for the elective surgeries in close collaboration with the anaesthetist and hospital matron;
- Lead the daily ward round in the IPD, mentoring/coaching local staff (nurse aids);
- Check out on IPD patient's therapy, treatment and recovery (including issuing of discharge orders);
- In collaboration with Hospital Director, organize and implement trainings and refresh trainings for the local health staff, based on identified training needs and according to the work plan established;
- Ensure that secondary health care project utilize standardized protocols, policies and guidelines as prescribed by MOH, CCM and donors;
- Provide continuous capacity building, monitoring and supervision of hospital staff ensuring the quality management of patients and delivery of care according to MOH guidelines, especially through CME;
- Be responsible for the health of CCM staff in the project area;
