Background:

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) has been working in today's South Sudan since the late 1990's. Since the country's independence in 2011, Welthungerhilfe has implemented 87 projects ranging from rapid disaster relief to reconstruction and long-term development cooperation projects with local partners, with an overall volume of over EUR 420 million. Through 19 projects in five states (Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Unity State, Western, Central and Eastern Equatoria), we supported 610,000 people in 2020 alone. Welthungerhilfe receives institutional grants from German federal funds (GFFO, BMZ, GIZ), UN (WFP, FAO, SSHF) and the European Trust Fund (EUTF). WHH SSD primary areas of work in South Sudan are food security, agriculture, food systems, nutrition, WASH and infrastructure rehabilitation, under the overarching umbrella of climate resilience and adaptation. Established in Germany in 1962 under FAO-led campaign against hunger, currently operates in 36 countries globally.

WHH is currently looking for a qualified and seasoned Roving Safety and Security Coordinator to support the Safety and Security Department in smooth safety and security management of WHH operations in South Sudan.

Job purpose:

The position holder will support oversee the safety and welfare of staff. This will be achieved through the development, implementation, and monitoring of an effective strategy to mitigate risks, maintain continuity of operations, thereby securing the safety and security of all staff, visitors, consultants, and Property. The position holder will be based in Juba, with frequent travel to Project locations through 19 projects in five states (Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Unity State, Western, Central and Castern Equatoria).

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Key responsibilities

- Provide technical support to the Area Manager, HOP's and SFP on all policies, procedures, guidelines and planning for staff safety, operational security, and program continuity.
- Evaluate and review the security management, security risk assessment, and contingency plans updated by field coordinators on a regular basis in compliance with global safety and security standards and requirements.
- Ensure humanitarian access approaches are responsive to local context and include overarching community engagement components.
- Ensure that WHH, its mission, and work in the areas of operations is known and accepted, not only tolerated.
- In close coordination with the SA, ensure sufficient funds are budgeted in proposals to implement security and safety enhancements for WHH facilities and train WHH staff.
- Make sure that at least once a year, a dedicated meeting is organized at SMT level to discuss WHH risk appetite for each location.
- Work with SA to ensure security budgets and staffing levels are in alignment with the assessed levels of risk in each location.

Your profile:

- University degree in Business/Organizations Management, Political Sciences, Security Management, or related field, preferred. Technical degree or certification in related field with significant applicable experience.
- At least three years' experience of operational access and security support of multi-sector humanitarian relief or development projects in East Africa or similar context, preferably at senior level positions
- Strong security management skills and experience,
- Understanding of local context, dynamics, and access limitations related gender, disability, religion, tradition, and local norms. *
- NGO experience and knowledge of donor requirements.
- Flexibility, adaptability, culturally sensitivity, team player.
- Fluency in spoken and written English is required. Arabic is a plus.
