Organisation & programme information	Caritas Switzerland (CaCH) is an International Non-governmental Organisation (INGO) which works worldwide and adheres to international humanitarian principles.  In South Sudan, CaCH implements comprehensive recovery projects to provide basic services that aim for increased resilience among the communities by improving food security, promoting sustainable Natural Resource Management and increasing income possibilities for the beneficiaries.  CaCH has its Country Office in Torit and since early 2022 a small Liaison Office in Juba, for which Caritas Switzerland is seeking a MEAL & Networking Coordinator. The objectives are to ensure a strong presence in Juba and to support the management and implementation of programs in Central and Eastern Equatoria States through quality monitoring, evaluation and learning systems.
