MAG employs Mine Action Team Medics as part of multi- Task Mine Action Teams. A Medic will be expected to carry out some or all of the following activities:

- Medical support to Manual and Mechanical Clearance of suspected mined areas as part of a Multi Task Team.
- Ensuring that medical drills and procedures are carried out as trained and as per Standard Operating Procedures, (SOPs).
- Maintenance and care of the Multi Task Teams medical equipment, medical supplies and all other equipment within the project.
- Maintain appropriate records as per MAG procedures.
- Report to the Technical Field Manager any deficiencies and medical logistical requirements in a timely fashion.
- Ensure that the medical evacuation plan for a demining task is understood, maintained and updated as appropriate in cooperation with the TFM.
- Assist in any medical training to the field staff.
- Any other duties as required by the Technical Operations Manager / Technical Field Manager ensuring high level of hygiene, clean accommodation areas/ working areas, welfare of the staff and sustaining high performance of all staff for the duration of the project.

- Fluency in oral and written English.
- Minimum of 3 years College institution in medical field (must produce documentation to this effect)
- Minimum of 2 Years work experience in the relevant field.
- Previous Medic Accreditation will be an advantage.
