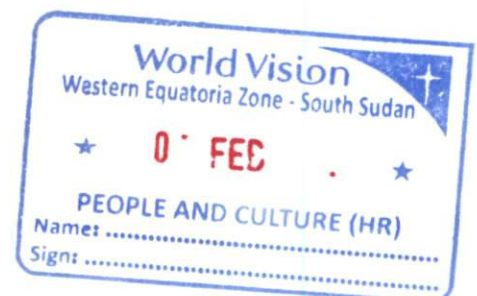
Purpose of the position:

World Vision is providing essential WASH services in South Sudan, with interventions in all the 3 counties of Western Equatoria State, designed to: enhance delivery of integrated WASH services, expand community WASH services for consumption, prevention, control, and support stable health systems that are responsive and accountable to the needs of communities and individuals accessing these services. To ensure thoughtful implementation considering the unique needs of vulnerable and at-risk groups, World Vision is seeking an WASH Project Officer to be based in Tambura to support in the implementation of the JPF funded WASH/COVID 19 response project. The incumbent shall work with the supported IDPs to uphold WASH/COVID-19 activities in Tambura.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

Coordination and Partnership

- Coordinate hygiene, sanitation and community participation activities of the organization with line departments (county Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Officer, RRC etc.)



- Coordinate with the department of public utility, the relevant authorities, the cluster agencies and community leaders for the involvement of all stakeholders and sustainability of the program

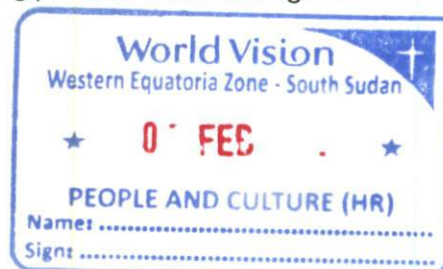
Implementation

- Providing advice and support on technical WASH Component
- Planning and implementation of hygiene promotion training and practical activities for IDPs, primary schools' students and staff.
- Planning and implementation of water management and hand-pump care takers trainings and supervision of water management committees work, in coordination with the relevant stakeholders
- Organize and coordinate distribution of soap and sanitary kits to IDPs sites and school girls of reproductive age
- Monitoring access to water and water quality testing through regular water quality analysis and ensure disinfection of any water sources which show contamination
- Design and supervision of boreholes and water yard points, latrines, solid waste pit construction and rehabilitation
- Supervise all the WASH hardware constructions ensuring that they are done following World Vision International guidelines.
- Facilitation community hygiene promotion through community meetings, in schools, health facilities, campaigns, radio program and social occasions.
- Conduct campaigns in the IDPs sites on emergency construction of pit latrines and seeking always for the maximum involvement of the community.
- Carry out assessments and other relevant studies, individually or with partners
- Ensure regular and timely documentation of and reporting of the WASH activities, the general WASH situation in IDPs sites and collection of project indicators according to World Vision International and donor standards.
- Regular monitoring and follow up of partners to ensure the proper implementation of planned activities by coordinating with the field office.
- Perform any other program or operations duty assigned by the WASH Project Manager

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Minimum 2 years' experience in infrastructure works or in Water and/or Sanitation Project implementation. And 1 years' experience in fragile context programming.
- Experience supervising construction teams/contractors in water supply and sanitation construction works
- Minimum Degree in Civil/Water Engineering or Building Construction.
- Willingness to work under pressure in unstable security and remote location with basic necessities a big plus.
- Skills in project management, including managing resources, and financial and budget planning
- Skills in Hygiene Promotion, Community Total-led Sanitation (CLTS) and Participatory Hygiene and Sanitation Tools Methodology (PHAST) desirable.
- Experience and skills in community mobilization.
- Skills and experience in conducting water quality analysis using portable water testing kits.



- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Having demonstrated organizational, interpersonal and communication skills; organized, efficient, and able to work long hours to meet deadlines
