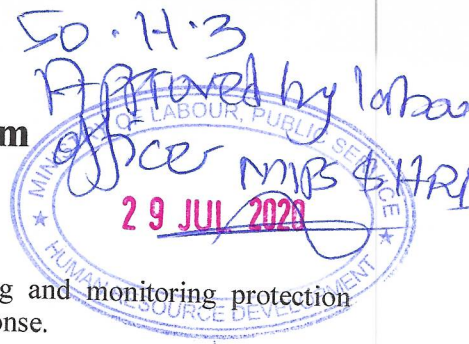




## Protection Officer Emergency Response Team Juba Based



**Job Purpose:** The Protection Officer will be responsible for implementing and monitoring protection mainstreaming activities for the Emergency Response Team's COVID-19 response.

### Key Responsibilities

#### Implementation, Reporting, Monitoring, and Evaluation:

- Conduct interviews (FGDs and KIIs) to understand the protection issues and risks.
- Monitor, analyse, and provide reports on the protection conditions for returnees/IDPs/host communities and other persons of concern in the areas of intervention.
- Identify protection gaps in interventions.
- Ensure protection mainstreaming is incorporated in the response.
- Share recommendations on how better to incorporate protection mainstreaming. Refer beneficiaries to other partners as necessary

#### Coordination

- Actively coordinate with other NGO partners, community members and leaders, and the local authorities

#### Training

- Provide training and supportive supervision to health care workers including GBV, CMR, and child protection in the context of the COVID-19 outbreak.
- Advocate for appropriate measures to remedy violations and address the protection concerns facing the returnees/IDPs/host communities.
- Provide support, guidance, and assistance to ERT staff on protection priorities, issues, and concerns.
- Perform other duties as may be required.

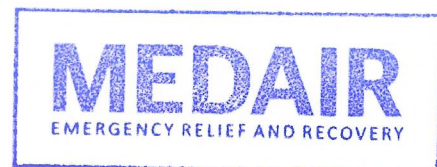
### Person Specifications
