Purpose of the position:

The Project Manager will be responsible for overall management for South Sudan Humanitarian Fund (SSHF) multisector Emergency Response Project to be implemented in Three Counties of Warrap State (Tonj North, Tonj South and Tonj East). The Project Manager will oversee program implementation and financial management, and project staff with diverse backgrounds. As this is an emergency program, the project manager should be someone who has ability and skills of delivering results in a fragile context in a short period. The Project Manager will be accountable for delivering all project. The Project Manager reports to the Zonal Program Manager for Greater Bhar El Ghazal and closely coordinate with technical managers, County Team Leaders and other relevant staff.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Give technical leadership in project planning, implementation, monitoring and ensure the project implemented and reported as per the design.
- Gather and compile information from the Project Officers and prepare overall performance progress reports (annual and semi-annual reports) detailing achievements against plan and variance on a regular basis.
- Support relevant reporting functions, particularly at outcome and impact level, notably including the bi-annual, Child Well-being, financial and procurement plan in adherence to the project. Ensure proper documentation of beneficiary screening, input distribution and other project meetings.



- Provide technical lead in the area of food security and agricultural development including nutrition, building staffs and partner capacity through technical support and training in the area of crops, vegetable, fisheries, extension system and to ensure smallholder farmers have knowledge on improved agriculture practices improved, farming as business, trained and get access to agricultural inputs (seed and tools).
- Facilitate the natural resource management improved with food utilization knowledge and practices among communities, implement and coordinate proper planning, monitoring, and reporting of the project activities and prepare work plan, DIP and procurement plan for the project.
- Prepare and submit quality project report as per the report requirement of the project, build and maintain effective relationships with implementing partners, staffs and stakeholders during the period of this project. Ensure proper budget planning and expenditure monitoring for the economic development component of the project.
- Do other task given to him or her by the supervisor.

- Degree in Project Management, Agriculture, public health and social science or related field but with direct experience in Public health, food security, protection and Nutrition; Master's degree is preferable.
- Minimum 3-6 years with similar experience as project manager in integrated project.

- Experience of integrated project management with different component
- Experience of facilitating Project planning, proposal writing, budget, donor report and timely report.
- Must have a love for children and demonstrate patience, tolerance, problem solving, open-mindedness and interest in social justice.
- Basic written / speaking English strongly preferred
- Local language as first language strongly preferred
- Proficiency in using computer software e. g MS Windows, MS office programs and internet.
- Ability to work under pressure in unstable security and remote environment is an asset;
