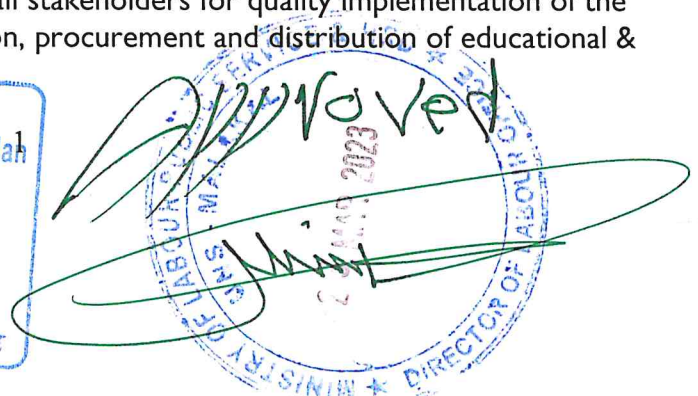
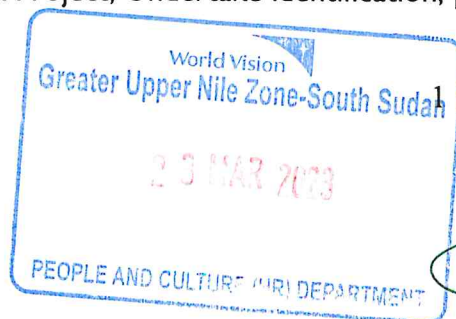
Purpose of the position:

Provide technical support and leadership for WVSS Education sector programming in all zones of South Sudan. Additionally, the Education Technical Manager participates coordination meetings including representation of World Vision at key Institutions at the national and state level especially Ministry of Education & General Instruction meetings, cluster meetings and technical working groups. The incumbent will participate in resource acquisition by providing technical input into proposals as needed, and provides leadership in the development of education technical models, theory of change as well as NO office strategy development

The Education Technical Manager also provides support to all education project managers to ensure education grants are implemented well and are technically sound. He/she may be asked to directly provide day to day management support to one or two grants as needed. This role reports to the Zonal Program Manager for Upper Nile with matrix reporting relationship with the Operations Director

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Management of EMPOWER Integrated EiE & CP /GBV project in (including financial, administrative and human resource functions) to ensure quality implementation that adheres to WV and donor standards, policies and other requirements; Mobilize and sensitize the communities of the targeted locations and all stakeholders for quality implementation of the EMPOWER Project; Undertake identification, procurement and distribution of educational &



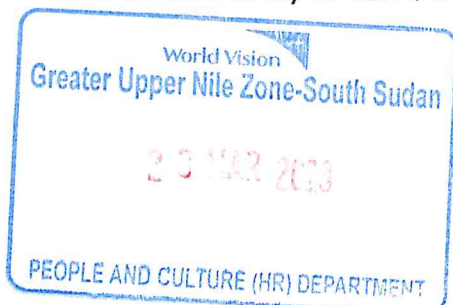
Protection/GBV materials, This includes ensuring strong safeguarding and PSEA awareness, and prevention mechanisms .

- Technical support to other education project teams, review of reports and sharing policy approved policy documents and project models (including narrative, financial and project reviews with zonal teams)
- Participate in Coordination meetings and initiatives of the clusters and government, local leaders, UN and other relevant stakeholders at country and state level to improve WV visibility, partnership and networking with all relevant duty bearers Ensure diversity and team work, coach and mentor World Vision education project teams and local partners in order to build their capacity, and enhance team work for current and future program management responsibilities.
- Ensure monitoring and evaluation of the education program/projects are carried out as per LEAP requirements and phases in order to improve implementation and impact according to the project design and future programming and Market the geographic area, engage and build relationships with existing and potential donors to ensure continuity in support and funding.

Required Education/ Knowledge/ Technical skills and experience:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Minimum of Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master degree in Education is preferable or a related field applicable to developing country. A master's degree in related field would be added advantage
- At least 3-5 years of progressive work experience in humanitarian response, mainly on education protection in an international humanitarian emergencies or fragile country contexts.
- Experience working with implementing partners as well as major donors such as EU, USAID, ECHO, Irish Aid, SSHF, among others
- Understanding of humanitarian relief, recovery and development work i.e. triple nexus in fragile contexts.
- Excellent networking, relationship building and people management skills.
- Excellent communications skills.
- Solid research, reporting, and writing skills.
- Ability to work in difficult, insecure and stressful conditions.
- Demonstrated ability to think, manage to plan and meet deadlines.



- Prior experience with World Vision is a distinct advantage.
