Lakes State SMOH works in collaboration with Doctors with Africa CUAMM in order to strengthen/develop strong healthcare systems, improve the accessibility/quality of medical/surgical treatment.

Doctors with Africa CUAMM is an international NGO working in South Sudan since 2007 and it is an INGO committed to the Safeguarding children and PSEA Policy and the candidate has to abide by them.

CUAMM's aim is to improve maternal, neonatal and child health, and nutrition services through a comprehensive approach of health system strengthening considering communities, health facilities, and hospitals as interlinked elements. Currently, CUAMM's operating areas are in Lakes, Western Equatoria States and Unity State.

SMOH is currently looking for a suitable candidate to fill the position of **Certified or enrolled midwife** to be based at **Bunagok PHCC** in Awerial County Lakes State.

Purpose of the Position: To promote good health and prevent illnesses through delivery of health care services at maternal child health department in the health facility

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide routine focused ANC and PNC services in the Health Facility or during mobile clinic in cattle camps and isolated communities.
- Provide skilled birth attendance.
- Provide BEmONC services.
- Evaluate and justify the need for the referral of complicated cases. Prepare the referral letter and ensure the mother is escorted on the way to referral sites.
- Promote individual/couple FP methods.
- Facilitate the integration of HIV/AIDS counseling/testing/curative services.
- Respect general hygiene and precaution rules.
- Ensure all instruments and medical equipment are sterilized after use.
- Prepare and submit to the Pharmacy Assistant the weekly drugs and medical supplies requisition.
- Ensure correct usage of drugs and proper management of all medical supplies and equipment.
- Take MUAC of all the PLW attending the Health Facility services
- Ensure all pregnant women receive an appropriate TT vaccination.
- Carry out weekly Reproductive Health education activities for patients and general public.
- Fill in the ANC register and the Maternal and Neonatal register.
- Issuing the Birth Notification Certificate to the newborns in the Health Facility and communities.
- Prepare all the reports required by Lakes SMOH, CHD and CUAMM.





- Provide general nursing care to mothers in admission;
 - Observation of patients
 - Vital signs, patients general condition and record them on the charts
 - Daily bed making and changing beddings
 - Dressing wounds as instructed by the Clinical Officer
 - Collect specimens as per request
 - Nutrition
 - Writing nursing care notes as per shift
 - Assisting clinician during ward rounds and medical procedures
 - Assist in conducting deliveries
 - Identify patients problems appropriately and respond to their needs
- Maintain equipment and do regular inventory;
- Train lower cadres;
- Reporting: Compile monthly OPD, inpatient and MCH reports in timely manner;
- Perform any other related duties assigned by the facility in charge, related to the PHCC activities and special needs;

Qualifications, Skills, and Experience

- Certificate in midwifery from a recognized health training institution (2-3 years formal training)
- Must have more than one year of clinical experience in a similar setting (documented voluntary experience or internship may be considered)
- Good knowledge of South Sudan MoH procedures and guidelines and general understanding of health service delivery, especially those related to women and children
- Thorough knowledge and skills of primary healthcare related programs in rural situations
- Must be a South Sudanese national
- Fluent in English (speaking, writing, listening and reading)
- Good communication skills in English, Dinka and/or other local language
- Ability to work with minimum supervision.
- Should be self-driven and able to work under little or no supervision
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Should be able to plan his/her work daily
- Able to observe a high sense of responsibility, ability and act efficiently
- Experience in preparation of reports
- Should be flexible and exhibit team work
- Demonstrates a systemic and efficient approach to work
- Relates and works well with people of different cultures, gender and backgrounds
