AIM OF THE POSITION

The Nurse Field Officer (FO) provides quality holistic care to allocated patients and ensures close monitoring and timely reporting of changes in their condition. S/he participates as a member of the patient-care team in planning and implementing quality holistic patient care. S/he could be assigned to specific nursing roles such as OT / ward / HDU based on contextual needs – always under supervision.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

The Nurse Field Officer:

- Provides pre and post-operative care in a holistic and professional manner in accordance with the internationally/ICRC recognized standards
- Ensures the ICRC principles for post-operative nursing care of the Weapon Wounded and trauma cases are followed and adapted to the circumstances
- Organises and ensures that all items required for the ICRC pre and post-operative care are available in the hospital
- Conveys information on patient care to his superiors through the established reporting mechanism.
- Shows awareness of patients' changing needs and adapts the planned care accordingly in cooperation with the patient-care.
- In conjunction with ICRC Head Nurse and Ward Nurse provides ongoing care of surgical cases and provide care to out-patients team.
- Adheres to ICRC infection control guidelines
- Liaises with the multidisciplinary team and contribute to ward rounds
- Performs the safest possible ward care according to the local capacity and environment
- Ensures appropriate communication with and a caring approach towards patients and those accompanying them.
- Monitors the ongoing needs for stock and utilises Imprest system for reordering
- Attends regular hospital team meetings.
- Provides ward statistics as required and participate in providing information for monthly and quarterly reporting.
- Maintains admission records of patients as required.

Required professional and technical skills

- Diploma or degree in Nursing with recent experience in surgical nursing and orthopedic nursing.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in similar position with international organisation
- Good level of written and spoken English and Arabic;
- Fluent written and spoken knowledge of any of the local languages is an asset
- Intermediate level in computer skills (Word, Excel and Power-point);
- Experience in working in a hospital and in the management of stock items
- Confirmed track record of providing professional patient care
- Clinical experience in hospitals and/or field hospitals
