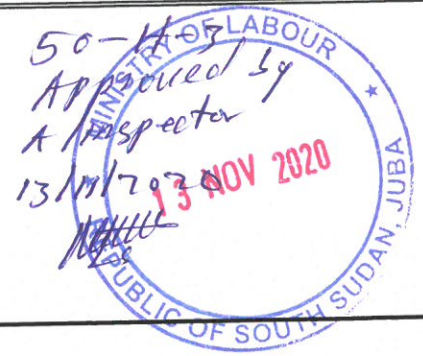

POSITION DESCRIPTION

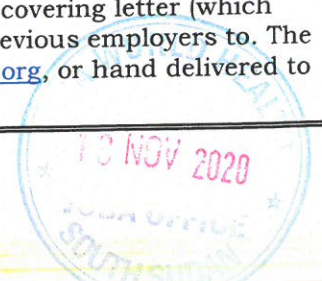
This position for the MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience project, led by IMA World Health, will report to the Juba-based Service Strengthening Advisor. The County Field Coordinator, based at the County Health Department (CHD), will work closely with the CHD and Health Pooled Fund (HPF)-implementing partner in all activities, supervision, and reporting. MIHR will recruit and assign one MIHR County Field Coordinator per county.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Liaise with County Health Department for planning and oversight of all activities aligned with the CHD priorities
- Support and supervise MIHR facility-based workers
- Determine best location and/or timing for outreach services
- Oversee reporting into DHIS2
- Oversee compliance with FP and PLGHA legislative and policy requirements, as well as commodity distribution and supply chain management
- Participate in implementing partner coordination activities and forums
