Purpose of the position:

The BMZ project Manager is responsible for overseeing all outcomes, outputs, and activities being implemented in South Sudan for BMZ Project. The position will also coordinate closely for the **Chapeau Project Manager** in the GFFO component and BMZ project coordinator to ensure linkages between the two projects of BMZ and GFFO to further Chapeau/nexus outcomes. The Project Manager ensures overall project planning, implementations and execution to ensure achievement of deliverables, output and outcomes of the project. This is a four- and half-year nexus project starting on 1st August 2022 to December 2026. Lead the planning process for all BMZ's food security and livelihoods interventions planned in the BMZ proposals, including distributions, trainings and follow-up

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Lead in overall project management which includes facilitating project implementation, monitoring and reporting of BMZ Project which is operational in Aweil East and North counties of NBeG.
- BMZ Project Budget and Staff Management Oversight
