#### 1. Description of the organization and its activities

Malteser International is the international humanitarian relief agency of the Sovereign Order of Malta. For over 60 years we provide relief and recovery for people during and following conflicts and disasters around the world. Christian values and humanitarian principles form the foundations of our work. In over 30 countries in Africa, the Americas, Asia, and the Middle East, we support people in need – regardless of their religion, origin or political convictions.

Malteser International has been working in the geographic area of today's South Sudan since 1996. MI implements a multi-sectoral program including Food & Nutrition Security, Livelihoods, WASH, health and peaceful conflict resolution. This includes activities such as agricultural trainings, cash distributions, food for education and access to water, sanitation, and hygiene. The program is aiming to increase its work with local partner organisations to optimise its sustainability. Furthermore, MI applies a participatory, gender sensitive and inclusive approach in its programming. As of today, MI maintains its country office in Juba while operating a program office in Wau and project offices in Uyujuku and Yei.

**Objective of SOB:** In accordance with the overall targets of above-mentioned operations, MI plans to order Supply and delivery of School Feeding Food items for three schools under 1 year framework Agreement in the mentioned locations Schools in Wau County.

The technical specifications and conditions of the tendering process are described below in the Specification of Tendering and in the Annex 2: Bill of Quantity which are part of this SOB.

Suppliers are invited to present tenders complying with the requirements here below specified.

# 2. Tenders Presentation

The tender shall be via E-mail to: mb.procurement-juba@malteser-international.org.

The deadline for the delivery of the tenders is: 18th July 2024 at or before 4:00pm

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- The tender should be valid for **60 days after the deadline.**

- The tender shall be submitted in one email including all the required documents as specified in content of tender

#### 3. General conditions

- The tender shall be typed or written and signed on each page by the legal representative of the supplier,
- The winning supplier might be requested to provide catalogues, pictures, technical descriptions and/or samples of items at the order stage when required,
- The prices of the tender will be expressed in United States Dollars. The prices must be on unit price basis as well as by totals,
- The prices will be considered fixed. No additional change of whatsoever nature and type will be accepted by Malteser International,
- Malteser International reserves the right to accept or reject all tenders depending on prevailing condition at the time.

#### 6. Ownership of tenders

MI reserves/funds ownership of all tenders received. Consequently, bidders will not be able to stipulate requirements that their tenders are to be returned.

# 7. Opening of submitted tenders.

The tenders will be opened on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024 in MI Wau Office, in South Sudan, by the Evaluation committee. The selection process will be recorded in writing by the committee.

#### 8. Tenders' evaluation Method

Tenders shall be evaluated according to the following procedure:

Firstly, tenders shall be checked on compliance of legal documents and evaluated on following exclusion criteria:

- 1. Not submitted legal documents as specified at 3. Tender
- 2. Not bided according to the specifications
- 3. Not Submitted tender within the stated time

Secondly, tenders found to be compliant and fulfilled exclusion criteria will be evaluated by an internal evaluation committee through a comparative bid analysis using the following selection criteria, which include both technical and financial criteria:

- Price/Rate
- Financial Capacity
- Delivery time (earliest date to Supply Food items)
- Experience in Supply of Food items with other I(NGOs)
- Not having its own warehouse in Wau, with the required food Items in stock. Partnership agreements of bidders are not accepted by the Malteser International.

#### 9. Contract and Payment Terms

- Framework agreement will directly be issued to the selected Company upon approval
- The payment will be done in United States dollars through bank transfer or cheque as specified below: Payment terms will be within 10 business days, at the end of every month, after receipt of food items, in the three Schools, upon receipt of Invoice from the supplier, and signed weekly delivery notes, signed by the School Administration and MI personnel.
