Introduction

War Child is a child focused organisation that continuously enhances its services to children affected by war and conflict. This includes striving to work with a range of different stakeholders and able to mobilise and provide services and technical assistance within and outside the organisation, as well as across its programme teams in various programme locations in the country.

As part of its Upper Nile program, War Child is planning to provide technical support to key stakeholders in Malakal County, Upper Nile with the view of strengthening their capacity on planning, implementation and monitoring of community-based peace building initiative. The role of a consultant will be contributing to the objective of peace building program through training and technical support.

Objectives of the consultancy service

The main objective of the consultancy service is to support the kick-off of the community led peace building initiative in Malakal County, Upper Nile State through training and technical support to key stakeholders at state and county level.

Participants of the training

- State and County level government representatives
- Peace building committee representatives
- Youth and women representatives
- CSO representatives including faith-based organizations





Key deliverables include:

- To introduce peace building policy and legal framework in South Sudan
- To help participants to reflect on prior peace building and conflict resolution activities
- To jointly assess strength and limitations of prior peace building and conflict resolution initiatives in the community
- Increase understanding and knowledge of participants on early detection and prevention of conflict
- Increase awareness on conflict analysis tools and approaches
- Equip participants with community led peace building and conflict resolution skills and tools including community dialogue facilitation.
- To introduce peace building program monitoring and follow up mechanism to participants
- To assist participants on community led peace building planning and action plan development
- Develop peace building manual for use by key stakeholders
- Report on pre and post workshop results
- Submit final report

Duration of consultancy service:

The consultant is expected to provide technical support for 20 working days including 5-7 days training. The working days can be distributed over a period of 2-month.

REQUIREMENTS

- The qualified candidate will be a candidate with BA/MA/ degree on peace building or related fields along with community led approach training facilitation experience in South Sudan
- Minimum of 8 years professional experience in similar work or consultancy service
- Strong training and coaching experience required; capacity and proven track record in training, including capacity building of local partners and stakeholders.
- Strong facilitation and report writing skills.
