

Introduction

- Collaborates with other nutrition staffs under the Food Security Cluster projects RDA

Participates in the nutrition cluster meetings at the ministry level.

Purpose of the position

The Scope is the "Community Food Security and Nutrition Activities in Yambio and Nzara Counties of Western Equatoria State". The Food Security & Nutrition Specialist shall support the Resilience and Livelihoods Programme Manager in collaboration with the NRM Officer to implement the project activities according to the project documents such as logical frameworks, rationale, budgets, and donor agreement.

Key accountabilities and Responsibilities *Project Implementation*.

Organizes and implements food security and nutrition activities such as training and support to lead mothers, education sessions, screening for malnutrition, village child days, kitchen gardens, cooking demonstration.

Takes initiative to enhance capacities of community nutrition volunteers and communities in the project zone.

Follows up beneficiaries in the villages to ensure proper implementation of the project activities.

Plays a leadership role in the fighting malnutrition and improving response to malnutrition in the project zone.

Promotes proper feeding techniques and good hygiene practices in the communities.

Participates in the production and preparation of nutrient rich foods and other nutrition dense food at each eatery and the communities.

Participates in developing nutrition related calendar events.

Organizes and conducts trainings for growth monitoring CNVs and lead mothers.

Liaises with the Ministry of Health and other institutions and organizations working on malnutrition in the State.

Executes other tasks related to his/her background and assigned by the Programme Manager but not specified under key tasks and responsibilities.

Capacity building

Monitors and follow-up regularly the work of the CNVs and lead mothers and provide them with support.

Identifies the capacity needs of staff and partners and provide solutions to fill the gaps.

Participates in the training of CNVs and lead mothers.

Supervises CNVs and conducts on job training to build their capacity.

Monitoring and Evaluation

Generates weekly and monthly reports which will include the challenges, best practices, lesson learnt and way forward.

Compiles all the nutrition weekly, monthly, and annual reports for the project.

Supports the PMEAL Manager in the development and implementation of robust M&ERDA

frameworks and tools.



Elaborates and submit the weekly, monthly, quarterly and annual reports as required.

Ensures the quality and accuracy of donor reports, in line with Cordaid and donor requirements and standards.

Reviews and assess project progress, captures lessons learnt and propose adaptation of nutrition strategies as necessary.

- 1. Degree in Nutrition, development studies, agriculture, natural resource management, socioeconomic studies or related field.
- 2. At least 5 years' relevant work experience in managing projects on nutrition, food security and livelihoods.
- 3. Practical experience in project cycle management, log-frame development, and proposal writing.
- 4. Good understanding of Cordaid standard in relation to nutrition, food security and livelihoods.
- 5. Good understanding and sound experience on cash- based programming. good understanding of cluster system and experience in coordination with various actors.
- 6. Practical experience of working with local partners and community capacity building. strong reporting, analytical and problem-solving skills.
- 7. Willingness to live in the field location with very basic knowledge of the local languages spoken in Yambio.
- 8. Excellent command of English writing and communication skills; and knowledge of Arabic and Azande language preferred.
- 9. Be diplomatic, culturally sensitive, result-oriented, innovative and a strong team player.
