Purpose of the position:

To contribute to the achievement of the strategic objective “reduction in under-5-mortality from common childhood diseases and conditions (AWD, malaria, pneumonia) in targeted communities in Renk, Melut and Maban Counties. The DPM will deputize the Project Manager on the implementation of the World Bank – UNICEF funded project, and he/ she will focus on achieving the project deliverables in Melut and will provide support to the consortium partner in the implementation of quality health project in Maban.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Support the Project Manager in the day - to- day implementation of the health project across the State (Renk and Melut - specifically) and support consortium partner in Maban in the achievement of project deliverables.
- Plan and facilitate monthly internal project reviews and quarterly reviews with involvement of all the stakeholders.
