### Instructions to service provider

#### Dear Service provider.

If you are interested in this tender, then you are asked to come to CEDS office Juba and pick the tender documents for filling.

- 1. Read the item specification (tab 2) and the evaluation criteria (on this tab)
- 2. Read the Terms and Conditions of the Contract, Ethical Code of Conduct & ECHO Principles (on tab 3)
- 3. Complete the Supplier Form (on tab 4) this is mandatory and submit together with your bid.
  4. Prepare your tender offer and include all the information and documentation requested (including your company's registration document, other legal documents and experience documents). Fallure to do so may result in the rejection of your bid. All prices quoted for the service should be in USD and should be exclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT) or other locally applicable taxes
- 5. Put all of your tender information in a closed envelope and return to the above address to arrive no later than 17th of January 2022. Envelopes are to be clearly marked with the reference: CEDS-Juba-2022-01 (Juba). You can submit your document in Juba office. You will be required to register in a book at the gate on submission of your tender documents.
- 6. Any queries about this tender should be addressed in writing to fo@cedss.org and copies of all questions asked by service providers and all responses will be provided
- 7. Service provider may submit a tender for some or all service according to their capacity to provide. CEDS reserves the right to contract one or more service provider in any combination. CEDS is not bound to accept the lowest offer or any offer.
- 8. CEDS are in no way responsible for any costs associated with preparing the tender response.
