## **ERT Senior Protection** Officer

Job Purpose: The Senior Protection Officer will be responsible for developing, implementing, and monitoring the protection plan for the Emergency Response Team in South Sudan and will include organizational representation at the Protection

- Key Responsibilities.
- Develop protection strategy for the ERT taking into account the context of responding to emergencies in South Sudan.
- Implementation, Reporting, Monitoring, and Evaluation
  - Design the protection components of assessments and interventions.
  - Conduct interviews to understand the protection issues and risks before an intervention.
  - Monitor, analyse, and provide reports on the protection conditions for returnees/IDPs/host communities and other persons of concern in the areas of intervention.
  - Contribute to donor and internal Medair reports and donor proposals.
  - Identify protection gaps in interventions.
  - Review reports from the field.
  - Guide/advise the design of implementations and implement the appropriate actions to respond to protection concerns of returnees/IDPs/host communities.
- Coordination
  - Actively participate in the Protection Cluster and other relevant meetings.
- Training and Capacity Building
  - Organise/facilitate relevant protection training activities.
- Advocate taking appropriate measures to remedy violations and address the protection concerns facing the
- Provide support, guidance, and assistance to ERT staff on protection priorities, issues, and concerns.
- Advise other Medair South Sudan locations on specific protection issues.
