Section .3. General Terms and Conditions for Supply Contracts

DEFINITIONS

In these general terms and conditions, the following terms are defined as follows:

- The terms "Purchase Order" and "Contract" are used interchangeably and also encompass
 "purchase contract," "supply contract," or any other contract, regardless of its designation, to which
 these general terms and conditions apply.
- 2. The terms "Seller" and "Contractor" are also used interchangeably and include the term "Supplier" as defined in any of the contracts above.
- 3. The terms "Buyer" and "Contracting Authority" are used interchangeably.
- 4. The terms "Goods" and "supplies" are used interchangeably to refer to the items covered by the Contract mentioned above.
- 5. The "partners" of the Contracting Authority refer to the organisations with which the Contracting Authority is associated or linked.

DELIVERY TERMS

It is the responsibility of the Seller to obtain any export license or other governmental authorisation for export.

PAYMENT

Payment will be as indicated in the purchase order.

Payment made by the Contracting Authority does not imply any acceptance of Goods or related services. Unless otherwise stated in the purchase order, prices are fixed.

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INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE GOODS

All goods shall be subject to inspection and testing by the Contracting Authority or its designated representatives, to the extent practicable, at all times and locations, including during the manufacturing period and, in any event, before formal acceptance by the Contracting Authority. The performance of any inspections of the goods, or any failure to conduct such assessments, shall not exempt the Seller from any of its warranties or obligations under the contract.

- 1. The Contracting Authority shall take ownership of the goods once they have been delivered to the final destination in accordance with the contract, have satisfactorily passed the required tests, and have been successfully installed and commissioned, as applicable, and after an acceptance certificate has been issued.
- 2. Under no circumstances shall the Contracting Authority be obliged to accept any goods that do not conform to the specifications or requirements of the contract. Acceptance of the goods may be conditioned upon the successful completion of acceptance tests. Furthermore, the Contracting Authority is not obligated to accept any goods until it has had a reasonable opportunity to (i) inspect the goods after delivery to the final destination, (ii) conduct and complete satisfactory tests, or (iii) confirm the installation and commissioning of the equipment, as applicable, with whichever condition occurs last. Payment by the Contracting Authority does not imply acceptance of the goods.
- 3. If the Contracting Authority fails to issue an acceptance certificate within 45 days from the actual delivery of the goods at the final destination, the successful completion of the tests, or the successful installation and commissioning, whichever comes last, the Contracting Authority shall be deemed to have issued the acceptance certificate on the last day of those 45 days. The issuance of the acceptance certificate does not release the Seller from any of its warranties under the contract, including those specified in Article 4.
- 4. Notwithstanding any other rights or remedies available to the Contracting Authority...Authority under the Contract, in case any of the Goods are defective or otherwise do not conform to the Contract, the Contracting Authority may, at its sole option, reject or refuse to accept the Goods, and the Seller shall promptly proceed in accordance with article 4.3.

WARRANTY OBLIGATIONS

Without limiting any other warranties stated in or arising under the Contract, or those provided by applicable product liability law, the Seller warrants and represents that:

- 1. The Goods, including all packaging and packing, conform to the specifications outlined in the Contract, are suitable for the purposes for which such Goods are ordinarily used, and for any purposes expressly communicated to the Seller. Furthermore, the Goods shall be of consistent quality, free from faults and defects in design, materials, manufacturing, and workmanship under normal use conditions prevailing in the country of final destination.
- 2. The Goods are securely contained, packaged, and marked, taking into account the mode(s) of shipment, in a manner that protects them during delivery to their ultimate destination.
- 3. If the Seller is not the original manufacturer of the Goods, the Seller shall provide the Contracting Authority with the benefits of all manufacturers' warranties in addition to the warranties stated herein.
- 4. The Goods meet the quality, quantity, and description required by the Contract.
- 5. The Goods are new and unused.
- 6. The Goods are free from any claims by third parties. They are unencumbered by any titles or other rights, including liens, security interests, or claims of infringement of any intellectual property rights, including but not limited to patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets.

Unless otherwise specified in the Contract, all warranties shall remain fully valid for a period of one year following the acceptance of the Goods by the Contracting Authority.

During the period when the Seller's warranties are in effect, upon notice from the Contracting Authority that the Goods do not conform to the Contract requirements...Contract, the Seller shall promptly and at its own expense correct such non-conformities or, in case of its inability to do so, replace the defective Goods with goods of the same or better quality or fully reimburse the Contracting Authority for the purchase price paid for the faulty goods, including freight costs to the final destination. The Seller shall pay all expenses relating to the repair or return of the Goods, as well as the costs relating to the delivery to the final site of any replacement goods, to the Contracting Authority. If having been notified by any means, the Seller fails to remedy the defect within 30 days, the Contracting Authority may proceed to take such remedial action as may be necessary, at the seller's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which the Contracting Authority may have against the Seller under the Contract.

The Seller shall indemnify and hold harmless the Contracting Authority from and against any

suits, actions or administrative proceedings, claims and demands from third parties, losses, damages, costs, and expenses of any nature, including legal fees and expenses, which the Contracting Authority may suffer as a result of any infringement by the Seller of the warranties specified in article 4.1.

AFTER SALES SERVICE

The Seller shall be able to handle requests from the Contracting Authority for technical assistance, maintenance, service and repairs of the Goods supplied.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAY

Subject to force majeure, if the Seller fails to deliver any of the Goods or to perform any of the services within the time period specified in the Contract, the Contracting Authority may, without prejudice to any other rights and remedies, deduct from the total price stipulated in the Contract the cost of such goods for each commenced week of delay.

However, the ceiling of these penalties is 0.1 % of the total Contract price.

FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be considered to be in default nor in breach of its obligations under the Contract if the performance of such obligations is prevented by any event of force majeure arising after the date of the Contract becomes effective.

OFFICIALS

The Seller warrants that no official of the Contracting Authority and/or its partner has received or will be offered by the Seller any direct or indirect benefit arising from this Contract.

CHILD LABOUR AND FORCED LABOUR

The Seller warrants that it and its affiliates comply with the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child - UNGA Doc A/RES/44/25 (12 December 1989) with Annex – and that it or its affiliates has not made or will not make use of forced or compulsory labour as described in the Forced Labour Convention and in the Abolition of Forced Labour Convention 105 of the International Labour Organization. Furthermore, the Seller warrants that it and its affiliates respect and uphold fundamental social rights and working conditions for their employees.

MINES

The Seller warrants that it and its affiliates are NOT engaged in any development, sale or manufacture of anti-personnel mines and/or cluster bombs or components utilised in the manufacture of anti-personnel mines and/or cluster bombs.

Anti-money laundering and combating the financing of terrorism

The Seller and any sub-Contractor/s certify/certify that none of the funds provided under this contract are used directly or indirectly to assist in, sponsor, or provide support for acts of terrorism or to support organisations or persons listed as terrorists on lists maintained by the United States government, the United Nations, the European Union, and other entities.

The Seller/s and any sub-Contractor/s authorise the verification of their company identity, whether through third parties or official government databases or by any other means considered by the Contracting Authority as appropriate for the compliance of its duties with anti-money laundering and combating the financing of terrorism (AML/CFT) policies and any requirements imposed by applicable laws.

Natural persons authorise the verification by submitting an informed consent form requested by the Contracting Authority.
