The Communications Officer is expected to drive social media activity for the programme and to manage content on the programme's website. Visiting MAF's partner organisations in the field and their beneficiaries to conduct face-to-face interviews to gather human interest and partner information to illustrate the impact of MAF's work within South Sudan
