Duties/Responsibilities:

- Participates in analyzing and planning coordinated nursing services in an assigned area.
- Gives skilled nursing care to patients requiring professional nursing service; gives prescribed medications and other treatments.
- Interprets care plans and demonstrates appropriate procedures to licensed vocational nurses, nursing aides, cleaners, and other staff.
- Participates in coordinating total clinic services in the interest of the patient.
- Assists families in achieving healthful, safe living for all age groups by giving instructions and guidance in the basic principles relating to accident prevention, communicable disease control, nutrition, child growth and development, and physical and emotional fitness.
- Aids individuals and families to accept and adjust positively to physical, mental, and social limitations.
- Keeping and maintaining facility equipment, furniture, and other items safe.
- Maintaining a clean and healthy environment for the patients.
- Sensitizing patients and their attendants about basic health care practices.
- Participating in Continuous medical education and on-the-job training sessions
