Position: Nurse
Duty Station: Gorom Refugee Settlement, Juba County, South Sudan
Period: Four (4) Months with a possibility of Extension
Direct Supervisor: Health Manager

Background:

Peace Winds Japan (Peace Winds) with funding from UNHCR is implementing an emergency health and WASH response project in Gorom Refugee Settlement and the surrounding host community in Juba County, Central Equatoria State, South Sudan. The project aims to strengthen community preparedness and response to public health emergencies, with particular focus on Ebola Virus Disease (EVD), Cholera and other epidemic-prone diseases.

As part of its preparedness and response to Ebola Virus Disease (EVD), Cholera and other epidemic-prone diseases, Peace Winds is strengthening infection prevention and control (IPC), case identification, referral and temporary holding arrangements for patients presenting with suspected infectious diseases.

Peace Winds is therefore seeking a qualified and experienced Nurse to support the operation of the temporary isolation/holding facility and provide nursing support to both inpatient and outpatient services within the health programme.

The position will play an important role in ensuring that patients presenting with suspected infectious diseases are appropriately assessed, safely managed and referred while maintaining high standards of infection prevention and control. The Nurse will also support routine clinical services and contribute to the overall quality of healthcare provided to refugees, IDPs and members of the host community.

Job Purpose:

The Nurse will be primarily responsible for providing safe, compassionate and quality nursing care within the temporary isolation/holding facility, particularly for patients presenting with signs and symptoms suggestive of Ebola, Cholera or other communicable diseases requiring temporary separation and observation pending further assessment, testing, referral or transfer.

The Nurse will also support outpatient and inpatient clinical services, including patient assessment, treatment, monitoring, health education, infection prevention and control, documentation and referral.

The position requires close collaboration with the Health Manager, clinical team, community health workers, laboratory personnel, referral facilities and other relevant health actors to ensure timely identification, management and referral of patients.





Key Responsibilities:

- Provide nursing care and monitoring to patients in the temporary isolation/holding facility, including patients with suspected Ebola, Cholera and other epidemic-prone diseases
- Support screening, triage, assessment, treatment, referral and follow-up of patients in accordance with approved clinical protocols
- Support inpatient and outpatient services, including patient assessment, medication administration, monitoring, health education and routine nursing care
- Ensure strict adherence to infection prevention and control (IPC) measures, including proper use of PPE, hand hygiene, environmental cleaning and healthcare waste management
- Identify and promptly report suspected cases, deteriorating patients and other public health concerns to the Health Manager
- Support preparedness and response activities for Ebola, Cholera and other disease outbreaks, including simulation exercises and emergency response activities
- Provide patients, caregivers and community members with appropriate information on disease prevention, treatment, referral and health-seeking behaviour
- Maintain accurate and confidential patient records, nursing notes, referral records and other required documentation
- Work closely with Community Health Workers, RCCE staff, clinical staff and other health partners to strengthen early identification, referral and community-level disease prevention
- Promote respectful, compassionate and non-discriminatory care for refugees and host communities in Gorom
- Participate in health team meetings, trainings, monitoring activities and other programme activities as assigned by the Health Manager
- Perform any other duties relevant to the position as assigned by the Health Manager

Required Qualifications and Experience:

1. Education

- Diploma or Bachelor's Degree in Nursing from a recognized institution
- Must be registered and licensed to practice as a Nurse in South Sudan or hold the relevant professional registration/licence recognized by the applicable health authorities
- Additional training in Infection Prevention and Control, Emergency Nursing, Public Health, Ebola/Cholera preparedness or outbreak response will be an advantage

2. Professional Experience





- Minimum 2–3 years of relevant clinical nursing experience
- Experience working in a PHCC, humanitarian setting or emergency response programme
- Previous experience in inpatient and outpatient nursing care
- Experience in infection prevention and control is essential
- Experience working in an isolation unit, treatment/holding centre or infectious disease setting will be a strong advantage
- Experience responding to Cholera, Ebola or other communicable disease outbreaks will be an added advantage
- Experience working with refugees, displaced populations or vulnerable communities is desirable

3. Knowledge and Technical Skills

The successful candidate should have:

- Good knowledge of basic nursing care and clinical procedures
- Good understanding of infection prevention and control principles
- Ability to safely assess and monitor patients
- Ability to recognize danger signs and deteriorating patients
- Knowledge of basic triage and emergency care
- Good understanding of Ebola and Cholera prevention, preparedness and response measures
- Ability to work effectively in an isolation environment while following appropriate IPC procedures
- Good patient documentation and reporting skills
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work calmly and effectively in an emergency or outbreak situation
- Ability to work as part of a multicultural and multidisciplinary team

4. Languages

- Fluency in English is required
- Knowledge of Arabic and/or relevant local languages spoken in Gorom Refugee Settlement will be a strong advantage
- Ability to communicate effectively with refugee and host communities is essential
