### Purpose of the position:

The Auto Mechanic will work across areas of operations to ensure Effective and timely repair and maintenance of WVI vehicles based in Juba with Periodical support to the Zonal offices.

Plan for fleet service, maintenance and track all documentations for accountability purposes.

#### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Conduct repair and maintenance services on WVI Owned Equipment including Light, Medium, and Heavy vehicles in accordance with manufacturer specifications.
- Conduct vehicle inspections.
- Carry out routine/emergency, electrical and hydraulic repairs, and maintenance on the above.

- Check/Installing Car log where required, downloading data/updating vehicle Car log system following maintenance.
- Ensure workshop is adequately equipped with safety tools/equipment, and they are always employed.
- Assist with documenting of vehicle maintenance and repair, assigning spare parts.
- Teach and share the experience with national colleagues to develop their work performance and professional skills in the respective area.

## Policy implementation

• Implement stringent measures to enforce policies on the control, use and management of workshop tools. To setup and maintain a clear record of all equipment, Only WVI fleet equipment granted for repair and maintenance unless approval attained from management to offer services to partners or government counterpart.

### Safety & compliance

- Ensure Health and safety measures are in place in relation to vehicles and equipment at the workshop
- Investigate all fleet accidents, service irregularities and operational status and make appropriate recommendations

### Staff Supervision

- Provide direct support to workshop subordinates
- Ensure effective performance management processes according to WV policies are implemented

#### Performance Management

- Maintain service records, prepares repair assessment reports, write reports, and submits them to the fleet focal Person in accordance with the established WVI repair procedures
- Determine vehicle write-off cases in accordance with the established procedures.

## Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience.

- Minimum of Technical/Vocational Diploma in Motor Vehicle Mechanics, Auto-Engineering or in a related field.
- At least 4 years of experience in an established motor vehicle workshop specializing in automotive electrical equipment servicing. Training in Automotive electrical



troubleshooting and repair, Vehicle Body Repair, Heavy equipment / Diesel Engines repair, Preventive Maintenance, and/or other related areas is required.

- He/she should have previous relevant experience working in or with a Transport department, preferably within the same industry. He/she should have years of experience in the mechanical industry with demonstrated capabilities. Mechanic Assistant candidates must have completed early experience in auto Vocational training and have Fleet Driving background with good knowledge of fleet assets part names and numbers.
- Should have knowledge in the use of automotive electronic diagnostic tools .
- Should have knowledge in operating various models of vehicles /equipment, Light Vehicles, Special Purpose vehicles, Material Handling Equipment, Ground Support Equipment, and Heavy Transport Equipment is desirable.
- Must have Commercial Driver's License or another relevant vehicle or machine operator's license.
- Should have Solid computer skills, including full proficiency in various MS Office applications Excel, Word etc.
- Excellent oral and written skills; excellent drafting and reporting skills. Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Should be able to work professionally and effectively in a challenging environment and multicultural team of international and national personnel.
- Should be Self-motivated, ability to work with minimum supervision and ability to work with tight deadlines.
- Should have Knowledge to plan repair and service vehicles, Boats, Motorcycles.
- The Candidate should be physically fit to do other work assigned by his immediate supervisor.
- Good presentation and communication skills for a number of different audiences.
- Fluency in English language and the local languages spoken is an added advantage.
