Community Support Initiative (CSI) is a non-political and non-profitable youth-led organization founded in 2012 to respond to needs for south Sudanese communities in order to sustain, Strengthen and promote better livelihoods through Food Security & Livelihoods, Health, General Protection, Good governance, Access to Justice & Rule of law, Education for all and peaceful-co-existence through Peace building and respect for human rights.

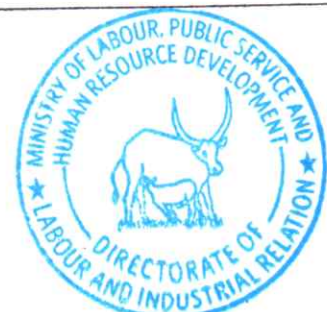
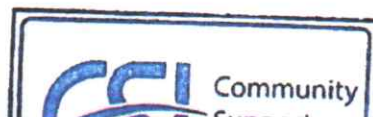
Since its inception, CSI has been involved at community levels through governance, access to justice & rules of law, women empowerment, Education, Food security and livelihoods, WASH, Health, Nutrition, HIV/Aids awareness campaigns, GBV, as well as Protection inclusive of mental health and Psychosocial support (MHPSS) and local based peace initiatives. Across all our interventions, inclusion of people with disabilities and other disadvantaged groups is mainstreamed to ensure protection of rights

Job Purpose:

The Protection officer is responsible for the day to day running of the general protection activities in Jonglei state including case finding, investigation, documentation, reporting of human right issues.

Key Roles and responsibilities;

- Ensure well-coordinated monitoring of protection issues by developing and maintaining good working relationship with the government actors, NGOs and UN agencies in the area.
- Promote understanding of protection issues and ensure observance of internationally accepted or legally binding standards.
- Actively participate in protection related meetings and groups.



- Advocate with the government and other actors to take measures to avert violations and address protection/Human right Concerns.
- Conduct Training on investigation, identification, documentation and reporting on human rights violations.
- Lead proposal writing for protection department.
- Conducts Human rights advocacy training to CSI staff, key government and community decision makers.
- Updating and Improvement of CSI human Rights violation reporting tools.
- Human right (HR) data storage and management training.
- Conduct interviews with the victims of extrajudicial killings, freedom of expression restriction, torture, arbitrary detention; harsh and life-threatening prison conditions, rapes, forced and earlier marriages.
- Document impact of human rights abuses including Gender based violence, child abuses, lack of accountability, justice and rule of law. This is to provide evidence and scale of abuse to the decision makers. Documentation also help in pursuing legal issues, advocacy purposes and for referral.
- Coordinate and lead advocacy with other agencies & sectors such as WASH, FSL, EDUCATION, HEALTH, Shelter/NFIs etc.
- Prepare Reports (Both internal and to the Donors).
- Be able to lead if he sees Protection needs.
- Perform other duties as may be required.

Qualification & Experience required

- Holder of bachelor degree in law or other social sciences from a recognized university.
- 3 years' experience from working as a protection officer or legal aid/access to justice in a Humanitarian, Recovery or Development context.
- Fluency in English, both written and verbal.

Application procedures

- This position is open to south Sudanese Nationals ONLY.
- The applicant must provide a detailed CV and Application letter explaining why s/he intends to work for CSI and why s/he believes to be the best candidate for this position.
