Job Title: Clinical Officers (3 positions)
Reporting to: Emergency Health Manager
Location: Kodok & Manyo
Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

The Mobile team Clinical officer is responsible for the day to day running of emergency health activities to ensure efficient and effective implementation of (PHC) integrated medical mobile clinics, community management of acute malnutrition (CMAM) services at a facility/identified mobile clinic sites in line with national MOH guidelines, programme plans, budget, and timelines. The role involves strengthening the capacity of staff at medical mobile clinic sites through on-the-job training. The Clinical officer take lead in all the (PHC) preventive and curative treatment at mobile team sites.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

Supervision of PHC activities

Ensuring all health activities at identified mobile clinics sites are implemented in accordance with South Sudanese health guidelines.

- Ensuring all medical supplies, stationary at all mobile clinic sites are requested and supplied regularly and timely to meet the needs of the beneficiaries.
- Promote active participation of county health departments, community structures such as Boma Health Committees if present
- Share daily, weekly and monthly health reports

People Management

Provide daily supervision and mentoring visits to staff members at mobile sites

- Manage nurses, midwives, laboratory assistant, and vaccinators contributing to their capacity building and career development
- Monitor and review performance of these staff and hold them accountable for meeting their objectives; give corrective feedback where required and take decisive action in the case of poor performance.
- Ensure that they are aware of and comply with all of WVSS's policies

Capacity Building:

Provide needs-based training for WVSS staff and partners on nutrition and health tools that will enable the teams to work effectively.

- Ensure that a sound understanding of PHC are filters down to front line staff and partners

Others

Be aware of, understand and comply with all of WVSS's policies and procedures (P4, finance, logistics, HR, security management etc).

- Contribute to ongoing security management and planning as necessary.
- Actively participate in any emergency response if called upon to do so (within the existing programme area or in a new one).
- Undertake other related duties as may reasonably be assigned by the line manager.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Degree / Diploma in clinical medicine and community health/public health/ Degree in Nursing/midwifery from a recognized university or training institutions.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in running primary health care activities in South Sudan
- Registration with Allied health professional or health authorities in South Sudan
- Energetic and self-motivated, with skills in community mobilization, training, and team-building;
- Proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision;
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines
- Be a committed Christian who espouses Christian values throughout his/her work
- South Sudanese Nationals only
