JOB PURPOSE

The Rapid Response Program Coordinator (RR PC) is responsible for coordinating Samaritan's Purse Rapid Response Program (RRP) under the management of the Rapid Response Program Manager. The Program Coordinator will coordinate health, nutrition and water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) activities to ensure effective, efficient and timely implementation. The RR PC will ensure that program implementation and operations comply with Samaritan's Purse policies, meet the objectives outlined in proposals, and are delivered within the established timelines and budgets, while maintaining the organization's service standard, mission and vision.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING. OTHER DUTIES MAY BE ASSIGNED.

- Implement, manage, supervise, and support assigned emergency WASH, nutrition, and health field activities according to project timelines, activity plans, and relevant national and international standards.
- Assist the program manager and MEAL team with assessments in areas with emerging needs, using standard tools to identify gaps and opportunities for response.
- Manage data collection, collation, and reporting processes to meet deadlines set by Samaritan's Purse, ensuring reports are shared with national and sub-national emergency coordination platforms.
- Assist the Program Manager in managing the local WASH, nutrition, and health teams, including recruitment, daily management, staff development, and training.
- Provide supervision, coaching, mentoring, and training to WASH, nutrition, and health team members to support their personal and professional growth.




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- Build and maintain relationships with local authorities such as the Ministry of Water Resources and Irrigation (MWRI), State Ministry of Health (SMoH), County Health Department (CHD), and key community stakeholders.
- Work with Program Managers from other sectors, including, Protection, and Ministry, to implement integrated multisectoral emergency programs for target populations.
- Lead project data collection, documentation, analysis, and reporting, ensuring data quality and accessibility for program design and ongoing improvement.
- Support the program manager with the procurement, storage, transportation, and distribution of medical and WASH supplies, working closely with the logistics team.
- Manage emergency response supplies, ensuring proper stock records are maintained.
- Assist the Program Manager in financial management within the emergency field location in alignment with the project budget.
- Maintain open and supportive communication within the WASH, nutrition, and health team.
- Assist the program manager with high-quality report preparation for weekly, monthly, and quarterly reporting.
- Uphold and share the ministry's values by evangelizing with beneficiaries and staff, embodying the values of Samaritan's Purse.
- Perform other tasks as assigned by the Program Manager.

QUALIFICATIONS & SKILLS

- Degree in Public Health. Additional certification or training in WASH is advantageous.
- Diploma in theological and biblical studies is an added advantage.
- Strong interpersonal, organizational, and networking skills.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills in English, with a high attention to detail.
- Good analytical abilities for data collection, documentation and reporting.
- Demonstrated problem-solving skills with a proactive approach to challenges.
- Flexibility and adaptability to work in remote or challenging locations, with a willingness for extended field stays.
- Proficient in computer applications such as Word, Excel, iForm, and Outlook.

EXPERIENCE

- Minimum of three (3) years of relevant post-qualification experience, with at least one (1) year in a supervisory role.
- Preferably two (2) years of experience in public health program implementation in complex humanitarian contexts, such as South Sudan.
- Familiarity with Sphere Standards and best practices for WASH, Nutrition, and Health, in emergency settings.
- Proven experience in project implementation, monitoring, and evaluation.
- Willingness and capability to deploy quickly and work actively across various emergency locations

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT

- Spiritually mature Christian, aligned with the statement of faith of Samaritan's Purse. Ability to maintain a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and consistently uphold the faith through witness and actions.
