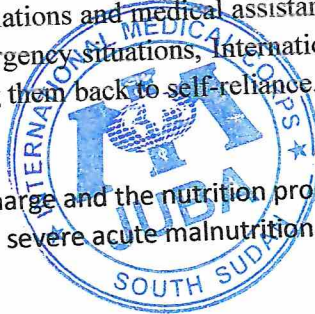


Organizational Background

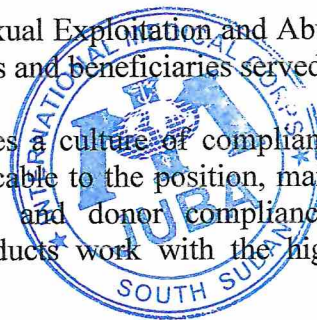
GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Good knowledge of Inpatient management of SAM, admission & discharge, transition between phase, management of SAM in child less six month and 6-59 months.
- Ability to identify, classify and treat SAM with complications in SC at phase I, transition phase and phase II, properly manage medical complication such as dehydration, shock, pneumonia, severe anemia, and correct micronutrients deficiency.
- Demonstrate universal infection prevention control practices in the working places by strictly adhering IPC guidelines.
- Perform triaging, manage & treat children with SAM with medical complication at the SC according to MOH & WHO treatment guidelines and participate actively in the daily ward rounds every morning.
- Ensure adequate availability of all medical and food supplies and ensure stock is pre-positioned as planned.
- Demonstrate universal infection prevention control practices in the working places by adhering to strict measure of IPC described in SOPs.
- Strengthen referral pathway system for children and caregivers to other sections such as EPI, ANC/NPC, OPD and OTP sites, as part of integration.
- Ensure all patients files information are recorded and filled according to SAM guidelines and ensure all records are kept securely.
- Ensure comprehensive health checks and treatment according to the protocols.
- Review the forms completed by staff to ensure completion, accuracy and coherence.
- Certify and submit the weekly and monthly morbidity and stabilization center reports on a regularly basis.
- Develop duty roster for Nutrition Nurses in the Stabilization center and ensure it is followed according to the schedules.
- Collaboration with staff from other agencies and SMOH
- Flexibility is required to all tasks given by Supervisor to ensure the provision of quality program intervention.

Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse

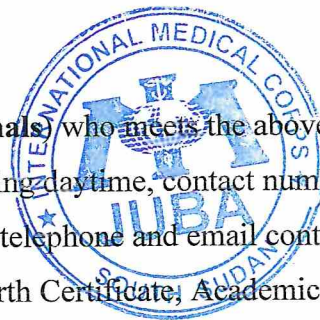
Ethical conduct for IMC staffs: The International Medical Corps maintains a code of standards of conduct that shall govern the performances of its employees engaged in the award and administration of contracts. No employee, officer, or agent shall participate in the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported/ by donor funds if a real or apparent conflict of interest would be involved. Such a conflict would arise when the employee, officer, or agent, any member of his or her immediate family, his or her partner, or an organization which employs or about to employ any of the parties indicated above, has a financial or other interest in the firm selected for an award. IMC officers, employees, or agents shall neither solicit nor accept gratuities, favors, or anything of monetary value from contractors, or parties to sub-agreement. These standards shall provide for disciplinary actions to be applied for violations of such standards by IMC officers, employees, or agents.

Personnel Requirements (special training/experience required, provide 6-13 requirements): Minimum requirements are:

- Diploma / bachelor's degree in clinical medicine or related field from a recognized institution.
- Must have 2-3 years of experience in managing primary health care services and Stabilization Centre as well.
- Strong organizational skills that reflect the ability to perform and prioritize multiple tasks seamlessly with excellent attention to detail.
- Very strong interpersonal skills and the ability to build relationships with stakeholders, and the community.
- Expert level in written and verbal communication skills.
- Demonstrated proactive approaches to problem-solving with strong decision-making capability.
- Must maintain strict confidentiality and demonstrate sound work ethics in performing duties and maintaining patients' information.
- Ability to work independently in extreme high-risk environment with no internet or telephone communication and able to take personal initiative, and multi-task including strong facilitation skills in an ever changing and extreme environment.
- A South Sudanese by nationality with excellent written and spoken English and Arabic language skills.
