Under the supervision of the Assistant Head of Sub Delegation, The Communication Officer 2 contributes to the design, planning and implementation of Communication projects and activities in coordination with the management of the Sub Delegation and Head of Departments and /or Communication Delegate.

FUNCTION DESCRIPTION

- The communication officer identifies public communication opportunities material to promote ICRC activities and to highlight the humanitarian situation he/she collects testimonies, photos and videos.
- Organizes and conducts dissemination training on basic IHL, the Emblem, Origins and Fundamental Principles to SSRC staff and volunteers. Organizes and helps deliver other SSRC courses such as training of trainers and coordination meetings.
- In collaboration with the line manager, act as a liaison between the ICRC and some authorities in Unity State. Develops, sustains and leverages a network of contacts with the State Assembly and other relevant institutions and ministries with a view to promoting knowledge and implementation of IHL.
- With the support of the administration, organizes participation of key stakeholders at external events.
- Consolidate data and compile monthly statistical reports for transmission to the COM Department according to the requirements.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- University degree or equivalent in a relevant field such as communications, political science, international relations, Journalism.
- Minimum 3 year's work experience in a field relevant to communication and/or prevention
- Fluent spoken and written English, and when applicable, the local language(s) of the context.
- Computer literacy – familiarity with digital communication tools
- Availability for frequent and regular travel on the field.
- IHL knowledge is an asset and Good knowledge of the political, social & media environment in the country/region of assignment
