Purpose of the position:

The consultancy work will start as soon as possible and all the processes must be completed **within 40 days** of signing the contractual agreement. The timeframe includes submission of reports. The task is very time sensitive, and hence in the work plan the Local Communication Specialist should present in detail how he/she will adhere to this timeframe.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Local Communication Specialist will ensure the following deliverables are met:

- 1) Provide a detailed Inception Report
- 2) Training manuals/modules/packages and technical guidelines translated from English into the local language (Dinka, Luo and Arabic) and podcasts prepared in both languages. This includes reports and written materials, as well as English, Dinka and Arabic recordings and audio-visual versions of extension packages produced.
- 3) The consultant will format (and re-format) the developed extension packages, modules, etc. to fit web pages, social media channels and print, including audio recordings, videos and screen casts for remote delivery.
- 4) Prepare audio recordings and audio-visual versions of the guides in Dinka and Arabic.

- 5) Repackaging/re-organizing materials and modules for training and policy briefs for dissemination using print, social media channels and web pages.
- 6) Translation of training materials for print and podcast.
- 7) Facilitate printing of the translated materials.
- 8) Preparation/Development and dissemination of training materials, advisory packages and modules after contextual interpretation, illustration and visual representation for semi/non-literate audiences.
- 9) Conduct training and refresher course on the developed materials to project team and key stakeholders' relevant government departments, at Aweil.
- 10) Validation workshop with the PMU including key stakeholders' relevant government departments upon completion of the assignment.

Required Education, training, license, registration, and certification

- 1) Advanced Degree in the area of Mass Communication, Media, or a related discipline.

Experience

- 1) More than 5 years of experience in implementing or managing similar works.
- 2) At least 5 years' experience in facilitating TOT and subsequent monitoring of TOT participants.
- 3) Well experienced in development and translation of training materials.
- 4) Previous experiences in similar works with recorded levels of success is desirable.
- 5) Good understanding of South Sudan social and political context.
- 6) Familiarity with the local economic environment of South Sudan and East Africa is an advantage.
- 7) Impeccable communication skills, especially with adult learners and semi-illiterate participants.
- 8) Good command of English, both written and spoken.
- 9) Understanding of Dinka, Luo and Arabic languages is a must.
- 10) Experience in social media.

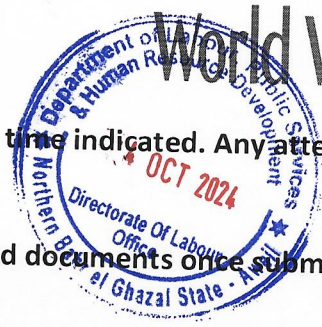
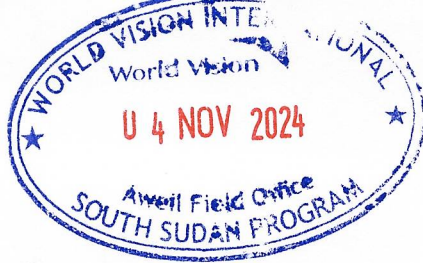

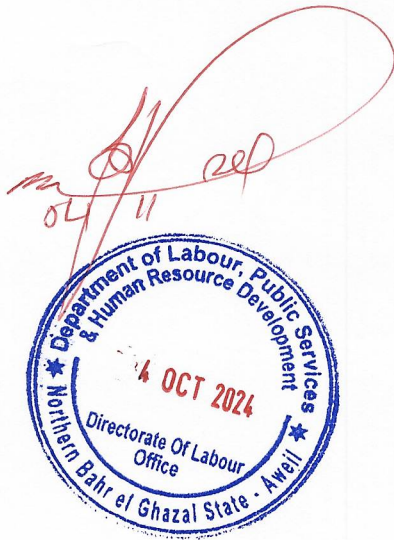
The online open vacancy will automatically close on the date and time indicated. Any attempt to apply after the deadline won't go through.
