- Liaise with the state and central office program team, including M&E and strategic information advisors, to monitor, analyze, and use data to identify areas of need, inform



performance improvement strategies, and allocate resources to improve program performance along key indicators.

- Support quarterly data and program review meetings with the state health department and key stakeholders.
- Identify, plan, and coordinate capacity-building efforts for healthcare workers involved with program implementation at supported facilities and communities.
- Work closely with the state health department, stakeholders, state TB/HIV coordinator, county TB/HIV officers, and representatives of service beneficiaries to strengthen mechanisms for the delivery of integrated TB, HIV, and sexual and reproductive health services in the state.
- Work closely with the CMMB technical team and all other clinical partners on setting TB/HIV program priorities and directions and responding to requests for support.
- Represent CMMB in all stakeholder engagements at the state level.
- Monitor and provide technical leadership to civil society organizations(CSO) implementing community HIV/TB activities in the state.
- Facilitate community engagements with health authorities, traditional leaders, community engagement focal persons, and religious groups to create demand for HIV case finding, promote community-based care and support, stigma reduction and retention of PLHIVs.
- Work with the county health department and other partners to integrate CMMB's community HIV/TB services with Boma and Payam health teams.
- Organize state-level community HIV/TB technical working group.
- Perform other assigned duties as required.
