**Job Purpose:** This position is responsible for providing ante-natal care (ANC) consultations with pregnant women at Gumuruk PHCU, and follow up post-natal care for women and babies after delivery.

### Perinatal Care

- Assess all pregnant women attending the clinic for antenatal care (ANC), provide preventative treatments including tetanus vaccinations, IPT and iron /folate supplements on recommended MoH schedule;
- Distribute non-medical items (e.g. mosquito nets +/- clean delivery kits) according to protocol to pregnant women at appropriate ANC visit and maintain accurate records;
- Assess all women attending antenatal clinic for danger signs or potential complications and make timely referrals as appropriate to COs or for treatment at secondary referral facilities;
- Provide health education to all women attending for ANC and PNC, including importance of hospital/clinic delivery, good hygiene, EPI and MIYCN practices;
- Encourage women who attend ANC to delivery at the clinic;
- Provide support and medical services to survivors of SGBV according to CMR protocol, provide psychological first aid and counselling, and refer to protection partners is appropriate and available;
- Implement all required COVID-19 prevention measures including the appropriate use of PPE to ensure essential services to all patients, including those suspected to have COVID-19;

### Community Mobilisation

- Liaise with community mobiliser and community nutrition volunteers and other home health promoters to encourage referral of all pregnant women and mothers with new-borns to the clinic for ANC, PNC and skilled birth attendant services.

### Administrative tasks

- Keep accurate and up to date records of all clinic attendance, education sessions, treatment prescribed and items distributed;
- Compile and distribute regular weekly and monthly reports on all activities as requested by Medair, MoH and partner organisations.
- Maintain accurate stock records of all medicines and non-drug items used in RH services
- Ensure availability of RH supplies, informing Medair Health Manager of RH needs for completion of a monthly stock request (including required stationary such as ANC cards, tally sheets, distribution items such as LLIN, clean delivery kits, soap and drugs);

### External representation

- To work closely with other midwives, health and nutrition staff in the clinic (whether Medair, MoH or other NGO employees)
- To liaise with CHD, MoH staff and representatives of other NGOs to ensure quality RH services are provided to beneficiaries.

- Diploma in midwifery or nursing.
- 2 years work experience post qualification.
- Fluent in spoken local language
- Fluent in written and spoken English
- Good interpersonal skills Self-motivated and Desire to serve the community.

- Fluent in Arabic
- Keeps a positive attitude in difficult situations
