The FYI team assists applicants to design various documents of their individual project including financial analysis, marketing analysis, technology analysis, budgets, management plans, implementation plans, and other project technical components. This requires the team to advance their skill in predictive analytics.</p> <p>It is in this context that this request for proposal (RFP) is situated, which aim to recruit the services of an expert who will be training our team in the predictive analytics. The consultant will take our team through the basic concepts in predictive analytics to visualize and explore data and understand the two core paradigms that account for most business applications of predictive modeling: classification and prediction.</p> <p>The use predictive analytics is the use of data to predict future trends and events. It uses historical data to forecast potential scenarios that can help drive strategic decisions. The team will learn (a) Data Analysis Fundamentals using Excel (b) Analyzing Data with Excel and (c) Analyzing Data with Power BI. At the end of this training, the team will be able to assist applicants to design and develop standard documents of the projects suitable for approval by USADF.</p>
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The overall objective of the *strategic development plan* is to establish a clear, systematic, predictable, and

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coordinated direction for the Foundation for Youth Initiative while planning and utilizing organizational resources.
The duration of the service is one month from the signing of the contract until the final report. Within this period, the consultant will propose the effective number of days to be remunerated.
