OVERVIEW OF THE POSITION

The Shelter and Settlement Unit within IOM is responsible for providing technical support and guidance for shelter, infrastructure, and settlement activities. These activities are aimed at improving living conditions for displaced persons and other affected populations. The activities' locations will mostly be in remote field locations and the incumbent is expected to monitor multiple sites. The activity types for 2024 construction may include: community infrastructure projects such as construction and rehabilitation of marketplace, vocational training centres, schools, individual shelters using local materials.

GENERAL FUNCTIONS

- The Shelter and Settlement Outreach Assistant will be responsible for providing field-based technical support to shelter and settlement projects. Specific duties include but are not limited to:
- Support the implementation of Shelter and Settlement activities in accordance with Sphere standards.
- Prepare construction inspection reports including measurement and quantity calculations, daily labour usage, photos, documentation of change variances, and progress reports.
- Provide technical input into the design and development of shelter solutions, including the preparation of technical drawings and bills of quantities.
- Collaborate with other IOM units and partners to ensure a coordinated and integrated approach to shelter and settlement interventions.
- Ensure that all shelter and settlement activities consider the protection needs and rights of the affected population, including gender, age, and disability considerations.
- Provide capacity-building support to local authorities, community groups, and other stakeholders in shelter and settlement activities.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- University degree in Civil Engineering, Architecture, or a related field from an accredited academic institution, with at least two years of relevant professional experience; or
- Completed High School diploma with five years of relevant professional experience.
