Project Summary:

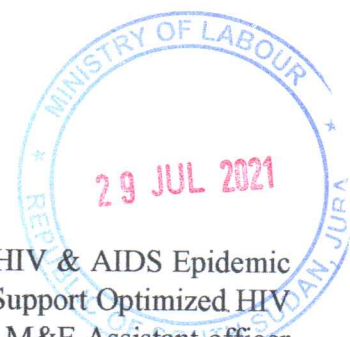
The purpose of Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) fund awarded to CIDO is to provide technical assistance and services to decrease morbidity and mortality among South Sudanese by increasing prevention, care, treatment, and retention services for at-risk men, women, children, and key populations

1. Increase prevention, care, treatment, and retention services for at-risk men, women, children, and key populations.
2. Strengthen the capacity of local partners to prepare them for the receipt of prime funding and implementation of corresponding activities.

Scope of Work

The M&E Manager will specifically support the IntraHealth Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) health project entitled Grants Under Contract Program: Support Optimized HIV Case Finding, Treatment, Viral Suppression, and Retention Services. The M&E Assistant officer will be responsible for all M&E-related project actions (project start-up, implementation and close-out) while collaborating with both with Program Team, other M&E staffs, IntraHealth, MOH and other stakeholders. providing technical M&E leadership within the health program with specific attention to data quality and use, s/he will be responsible for building capacity of staff in all M&E related work based on identified needs i.e. provide technical support on data collection methods, data analysis, data quality assurance and result-based management. S/he will also ensure quality data collected is entered into a data platform, data analysis is completed by project teams and will play a key role in the process of reporting on the impact of the CIDO program to donors. The M&E Assistant officer will conduct frequent visits to field operations to assess the quality of the programme, M&E work, ensure understanding and compliance with M&E procedures and provide guidance and coaching to staff. The incumbent will majorly focus to support in capturing community and facility HIV testing and ART data using MOH tools and track progress towards GUCs objectives and targets. Using, and building on the existing reporting systems S/He will continue community data and assign HIV service delivery indicators for prevention, testing, linkage, treatment, and viral suppression. Ensure that data will is disaggregated by facility, age, sex, nationality, HIV testing modality and result, community ART, among others. Ensure tracking of daily and weekly targets for each facility's community activities to facilitate monitoring progress towards achieving targets as well as tracking implementation of organizational development milestones that will be identified in the capacity building plans.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Coordinate with CIDO M&E Manager to ensure that the AHEC project has a robust monitoring plan in place, developing monitoring and evaluation guidelines, frameworks and indicator trackers for the project, in close collaboration with the Health Program Manager/Coordinator
- Support CIDO and AHEC Program Team and M&E staff with the planning and implementation of baseline surveys, needs assessments, mid-term and end of project reviews/evaluations including preparation of Terms of References and designing and implementing appropriate evaluation methodologies
- Attend periodic meetings with Intra Health consortium members on M&E progress, challenges and way forward
- Manage project monitoring information system / databases to ensure efficient and effective collection, entry, and analysis of all project data (both quantitative and qualitative) and proper reporting of the outcomes of all projects
- Provide support to the program team in compiling reports, stressing the importance of data quality, indicator-based reporting and analysis of trends and the achievement of program
- Conduct field visits to the health facilities to mentor and coach facility staff on data collection, reporting and data cleaning to inform program and HMIS/DHIS reports
- Review reports to ensure accuracy and quality before submission to technical coordinators/managers

- Facilitate training of health program staff and partners on monitoring and evaluation
- Develop Weekly/monthly indicator tracking sheets for monitoring of program achievement on a weekly/monthly basis and follow-up with the staffs on the usage of the system
- In coordination with M&E manager, ensure knowledge management (KM), emphasizing on the staff access to a library of M&E knowledge to help them better design-implement-evaluate the program
- Participate in the development of the program implementation strategy, annual work plans and other project tools
- Informs the Program health manager/ coordinator on the availability and short fall of data collection tools at the health facilities and community programming
- Support the operation of feedback channels (logbook, client satisfaction and engagement surveys)
- Support the recording of feedback, analysis and accessibility of feedback data for programmatic decision making
- Work closely with consortium partners and ensure participation of quality of care/intervention monitoring together with CIDO and partner project staff while ensuring availability of data at the facilities for assessing program quality
- Support quality improvement activities within the context of HIV/AIDS care & treatment.
- Willingness to work with Key populations

Policy Compliance-Mandatory Reporting Policy (MRP)

- Ensure any violations of the CIDO sexual abuse and exploitation code of conduct are reported to the health manager. The reporting of violations is an obligation on the part of all staff members.

Required Professional and Technical Skills:

- Relevant Bachelor's Degree in Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Public Health or field related to Data Management or Monitoring and Evaluation
- Minimum of 2 years' sound experience in Research/Program Monitoring&Evaluationrole
- Minimum of 1year specific M&E related work experience in the health sector, experience with HIV/AIDS



- Demonstrated experience in the implementation and management of M&E systems, involving capacity building for field staff, as well as monitoring and promotion of data quality
- Functional knowledge) in M&E reporting to USAID/PEPFAR and other bilateral or multilateral donors preferred.
- Proven ability to mentor programme site staff in M&E, data use for decision making and quality improvement
- Experience in managing large M & E program and managing & capacitating people
- Proven experience of creating data collection tools
- Proven training/capacity building skills in M&E
- Excellent facilitation skills, and strong understanding of how to safely and accurately collect feedback from all members of a community regardless of their age, gender, or other diversity factors
- Ability to handle multiple tasks; proven self-initiative and problem solving abilities
- Proven track record of quality performance in highly pressured environments
- Computer skills, including Word, Excel, Power-Point, and Access
- Proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines
