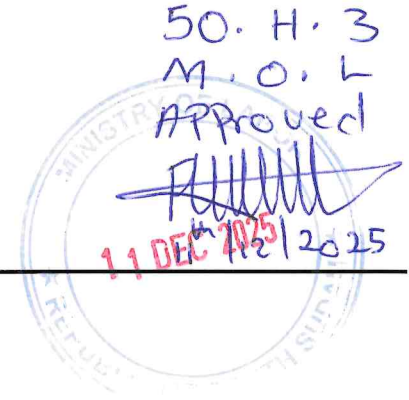

Organizational background

Position Description

This position for the MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience (MIHR) project, led by IMA World Health, will report to the Juba-based Procurement/Admin Officer. The Cleaner, based at IMA World Health Head Office, will work closely with all staff in based in Juba as well as visitors.

He/she will ensure the IMA Juba office, operates on a clean and organized environment, with regards to all programs in South Sudan.

Major Responsibilities:

Lifesaving Curative Consultation MNCH (70%)

- History taking, physical examination, ordering appropriate laboratory investigations and making appropriate diagnosis and treatment
- Promote rational drug use through MOH treatment guidelines.
- Champion IMNCI and MHN curative services
- Use BeMonc and IMNCI approach to attend to pregnant women and children under 5 years.



- Attending emergencies presenting the clinic and recommend referrals for cases that cannot be managed as per MOH guidelines.
- Ensure all required observations and vital signs; prescribed treatment and procedures are carried out and documented on patients' records and MOH approved registers.
- Boost patient experiences, including counselling and sensitizing patients through health talks preventive and promote health.
- Embrace, learn, and develop an evidence-based medical system.
- Consistent track record to work and deliver results with minimum supervision.

Drugs/Supplies (10%)

- Work with pharmacy on essential drugs required at the health centre and ensure rational use.
- Work with pharmacy staff to ensure pharmacovigilance is applied on general outpatient drugs.

Laboratory

- Work together with the Lab staff to ensure relevant investigations are done in a timely manner with the correct results and always ensure quality control.

Report Writing (20%)

- Assist in preparing and presenting monthly, quarterly, semi-annual and annual reports with the guidance of the County Liaison Officer

Trainings

- On the job Training of BHWs in the health centre and outreach clinics as appropriate.
- Perform other duties and responsibilities as requested by line manager

Qualification and required experience:

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine and Surgery
- Registered with valid practicing license
- Over two (2) years working experience working ideally in a busy health facility
- Knowledge of IMNCI and MNH management is key
- Experience in clinics for children under 5 years and Basic Emergency Maternal Obstetric Care
- Proficiency in computer applications.

Knowledge and skills:

- Good clinical skills
- Required to be team oriented with excellent interpersonal skills and ability to work under pressure in a stressful environment, displaying resilience, compassion and diplomacy
- Active team player with good interpersonal skills
- Good analytical skills
- Self-initiative
- Ability to work under minimum supervision
- Ability to work in a professional manner with fellow staff members, visitors, and the public.
